8 WHEREAS, the Oregon State Marine Board has long supported
9 the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office and its River Patrol with
10 money and equipment; and

11 WHEREAS, the Oregon State Marine Board in 1995 provided
12 Multnomah County with three new patrol boats and spare engines
13 and outdrives for MCSO's River Patrol fleet; and

14 WHEREAS, the Oregon State Marine Board provides marine
15 enforcement throughout the state and has need for a boat for one
16 of its enforcement programs; and

17 WHEREAS, MCSO has title to a 1975 Wellcraft, 25-foot boat
18 (Reg. No. OR 189XCX, Hull No. 00676M75AN25) and trailer which
19 would meet the Marine Board's enforcement needs in other areas of
20 the state; and

21 WHEREAS, publicly owned property should be put to its
22 highest and best use; and

23 WHEREAS, Multnomah County Administrative Procedure PUR-3
24 provides that the County may transfer surplus property to another
25 public agency without remuneration or competitive bids.

26 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Multnomah County Board
27 of County Commissioners approves the transfer of title of a 1975
28 Wellcraft, 25-foot boat (Reg. No. OR 189XCX, Hull No.
00676M75AN25) and trailer to the Oregon State Marine Board, for
no remuneration pursuant to Administrative Procedure PUR-3.
