## General Information

### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The Department of Community Services recommends approval of an Amendment No. 19 to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Portland for providing road maintenance to County roads in unincorporated west Multnomah County during FY 2017 – 2018. The existing IGA expires June 30, 2017. The amendment extends the term of the IGA through FY 2017 – 2018.

### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer(s) this action affects and how it impacts the results.

In 1984, Multnomah County and the City of Portland agreed that the City would maintain, through an IGA, all County roads in unincorporated western Multnomah County that were within the Urban Services Boundary. The City of Portland did not receive compensation for these services since the area was presumed to be annexed to the City. Annexation of the westside unincorporated areas has proceeded at a slower pace than was anticipated in 1984. In 1997, the City informed the County it would no longer maintain these roads. During 1997, representatives of the City and County developed the terms of this IGA. The City and County find the most rational and efficient method for delivery of road and drainage facility maintenance in this Westside area is for the City to continue to provide services.

### 3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

The City of Portland agrees to maintain the roads during fiscal year 2017 - 2018 for an amount not to exceed \$100,000. The amount remains unchanged from the previous agreement amendment which expires at the close of fiscal year 2016 - 2017. The funds necessary for maintenance of these roads are budgeted in the county road fund.

**4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.**

**5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.**

Discussions concerning this amendment were held by staff members from Multnomah County Transportation and the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation. Upon approval by the Board, IGA Amendment No. 19 will move to Portland's City Council for review and approval.
