WHEREAS, the Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center (P.O.I.C.) was founded 30 years ago to establish an employment training program; and

WHEREAS, the P.O.I.C. was founded by the Albina Ministerial Alliance who's mission became the elimination of unemployment, poverty and illiteracy in the greater Portland area; and

WHEREAS, the P.O.I.C. has been operating as an Alternative High School since 1983, serving 1512 students from the ages of 14-21, and has been approved by the Oregon Department of Education to serve handicapped children; and

WHEREAS, Rosemary Anderson has been employed with the Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center since its inception and served as its Executive Director from 1980 through 1986; and


WHEREAS, Rosemary Anderson was responsible for achieving accreditation of the POIC Alternative High School program in 1989 by the Northwest Association of Schools and honored as the 1996 Oregon Education Excellence Principal's Award for the Greatest Improvement in Academic Performance of At-Risk Students; now, therefore


