Proclaiming March 2019 is Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. People with intellectual and developmental disabilities are fully realized individuals desiring to live full lives in communities of their choice.
- b. People with intellectual and developmental disabilities are valued members of our community who make significant contributions to society.
- c. Multnomah County and its partners are privileged to provide services that support a person-centered approach to ensuring quality of life and equitable opportunities to thrive for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- d. Multnomah County serves almost six thousand clients with intellectual and developmental disabilities and facilitates access to a broad range of client directed supports and services.
- e. Employment support services allow individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities to be part of an inclusive, diverse workforce, earn at least a minimum wage, and be a contributing community member.
- f. Increased public awareness of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their contributions promotes engagement in a vibrant community.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:


