ORDINANCE NO. 51

An Ordinance providing for submission to the voters of Multnomah County, Oregon, a proposed amendment to Chapter VIII, Section 8.20 (2), of the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter adopted November 8, 1966, and setting a date for the election thereon.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of County Commissioners by Chapter XI, Section 11.50 (3) of the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter, there is hereby referred to the legal voters of Multnomah County, Oregon, the following proposed amendment to the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter to be voted upon at the Primary Election to be held on May 23, 1972, in Multnomah County, Oregon.

Section 2. It is proposed and accordingly submitted that Chapter VIII, Section 8.20 (2), be amended to read as follows:

- (2) The board may issue and sell revenue bonds in such amounts and for such purposes as it determines to be in the best interests of the county.

Section 3. The Director of the Department of Records and Elections be and he is hereby authorized and directed to place the proposed Charter amendment on the Primary Election ballots in appropriate manner and form for submission to the legal voters of Multnomah County for rejection or approval.

Section 4. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage.
