ORDINANCE NO. 318

An Ordinance referring a Charter Amendment to September 21, 1982 election.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section I. The following ballot measure shall be placed on the September 21, 1982 ballot of Multnomah County.

- Ballot Measure -

Section 1. The ballot measure amending the Home Rule Charter of Multnomah County adopted by the people on May 18, 1982 and referred to as Measure 6 is repealed.

Section 2. Section 12.50 of the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter is amended by adding subsection 3 to read as follows:

(3) The Committee shall also study and report on all matters contained in the Charter Amendments adopted May 18, 1982 and referred to as Measure 6.

Section II. The election on September 21, 1982 shall be conducted by mail pursuant to state law.

Section III. Attached and marked Exhibit A is the ballot title for the election unless amended by the Circuit Court.

EXHIBIT A

Ballot Title

Caption: Repeal of charter amendments and referral to Charter Review Committee.

Question: Shall charter amendments adopted in 1982 Primary be repealed and those issues be studied by Charter Review Committee?

Statement of Purpose: This measure would amend the County Charter by repealing amendments adopted in the 1982 primary election. A Charter Review Committee will commence study of the charter in 1983. This measure would require that Committee to study and report on the election of a County Sheriff, Clerk, District Court Clerk and Assessor. The committee would also study issues relating to the county lobbyist and salaries and tenure in office of elected county officials.
