

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

FOR THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH

ORDINANCE NO. 417

An ordinance amending Chapter 5.40 of the Multnomah County Code, the Car Rental Tax, by repealing certain criteria constituting doing business within the County, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Findings.

MCC 5.40.010(C) 3. and 4., when enacted by the Board were not intended to subject any car rental transaction consummated outside Multnomah County, and which may be subject to a tax imposed by a jurisdiction outside Multnomah County, to an additional tax as required by those provisions. Accordingly, the Board does find that the effect of said provisions is likely to result in consequences not intended by the Board and should be repealed.

SECTION II. Amendment.

MCC 5.40.010(C) is amended by repealing and deleting therefrom subparagraphs (C) 3. and 4.

SECTION III. Adoption and Declaration of an Emergency.

The Board concludes that an emergency does exist in that the repealed provisions herein do present an unintended burden upon car rental patrons and a consequence of sufficient importance to warrant immediate effectiveness of the ordinance. Accordingly, this ordinance shall be effective, pursuant to HRC 5.30(3) and 5.50(2), immediately upon its passage by the Board and signing by the County Executive.
