ORDER NO. 93-288

WHEREAS, the Director of the Oregon Department of Revenue has found that Linnton Plywood Association had good and sufficient cause for failing in 1992 to timely file an application for pollution control tax exemption, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Oregon Department of Revenue has recommended that the Association's pollution control tax exemption be reinstated for the tax year 1992-93, and

WHEREAS, the Assessor for Multnomah County has approved the recommendation and transmitted it to the Board, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wholly accepts the recommendation; it is

ORDERED that the Tax Collector for Multnomah County reinstate the Association's pollution control tax exemption for 1992-93, strike the taxes so assessed and refund the taxes so paid.


