Approving a proclamation honoring the service of two founding Board members of Central City Concern – Dean Gisvold and George “Bing” Sheldon.

Central City Concern (CCC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit agency serving single adults and families in the Portland metro area who are impacted by homelessness, poverty and addictions. Founded in 1979, the agency has developed a comprehensive continuum of affordable housing options integrated with direct social services including affordable housing, healthcare & recovery, employment and peer support. CCC currently has a staff of 600+, an annual operating budget of \$41 million and serves more than 13,000 individuals annually. Central City works closely with Multnomah County's Department of County Human Services, Community Justice, and the Health Department to deliver services. Bing Sheldon was a founding member of the Board (35 years) and Dean Gisvold has been on the board for 33 years, 26 consecutive years as board chair. In addition, both men had instrumental roles in the Downtown Plan of 1972 for the City which has shaped the vibrant community we live in today. Both Dean and Bing will leave the Board at the end of June, 2013.


