BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR
MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
ORDINANCE NO. 65

An Ordinance prohibiting the use, display or wearing of police uniforms which are deceptively similar to the official police uniforms of the Department of Public Safety.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person within the jurisdiction of Multnomah County, Oregon, shall wear, use or display the official uniform of an officer of the Department of Public Safety of said County or any distinctive part of such uniform, or a uniform, any part of which is similar to a distinctive part of such uniform, or a uniform which, on the whole, is deceptively similar to such official uniform, unless such person is authorized by law to do so. Members of the Sheriff's Reserve are not so authorized.

Section 2. Violation of this Ordinance is punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not to exceed six (6) months, or both.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect ninety (90) days after its passage.
