RESOLUTION NO. 2015-103

Disposal of Abandoned Vessels Left On Multnomah County Waterways.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Multnomah County Code Chapter 15.650-15.656 provides for the Sheriff to seek authorization from the Board of County Commissioners to dispose of unclaimed property by transfer to law enforcement or government agencies; offered for sale; or disposal through destruction.
- b. The abandoned vessels have been left unclaimed on public waterways in Multnomah County. The Sheriff's Office River Patrol Unit has made attempts to contact the last known registered owners, but have been unable to locate anyone who will take responsibility for them. Destruction of these vessels is essential to protect the sensitive river ecosystem and discourage the dumping of unwanted vessels in the future.

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:

1. The Oregon State Marine Board will take possession of the following vessels and destroy them:
 - a. 1959 home built 14-foot boat; OR 209CLA
 - b. 1977 Reinell 24-foot boat; OR 860UA
