WHEREAS, on September 8, 1986 the Office of the County Auditor released Internal Report #2-86 concerning criminal justice information systems in Multnomah County recommending that a justice services data consortium explore the possibilities of interfacing the various criminal justice data systems;

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1986 the Board of County Commissioners directed the development of a plan for an integrated, offender-based criminal justice information system in Multnomah County;


WHEREAS, the Multnomah County Data Processing Management Committee presented a plan for the development of an integrated criminal justice information system on February 4, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to ensure systematic completion of the development and implementation of the planned offender-based, integrated criminal justice information system in Multnomah County;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board (A) establishes this policy of support for the complete development and implementation, under the direction of the Director, Department of Justice Services, of an offender-based integrated criminal justice information system in Multnomah County, and (B) directs that any development or enhancement of criminal justice information application systems be consistent with the goal of an integrated system;


THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that until implementation of the integrated criminal justice information system is satisfactorily completed, the step-by-step development and implementation of an integrated criminal justice information system will be given a high priority for funding among County data processing projects.
