Ordinance No. 94

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 89 to provide for continuation of existing civil service rules and regulations, and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment.

Section 29 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 29. Conformance With Law.

"This ordinance shall in no way be a substitute for or eliminate the necessity of conforming with any and all county, state, and federal equal employment opportunity laws, or rules and regulations pertaining thereto."

Section 2. Amendment.

Section 32 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 32. Ordinance Repeal.

"Multnomah County Ordinance No. 10 is hereby repealed."

Section 3. Amendment.

Section 33 of Ordinance No. 89 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 33. Adoption.

"This ordinance is immediately necessary to implement the revised

personnel system in the county, an emergency is therefore declared and this ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption; provided, however, all rules and regulations promulgated under Ordinance No. 10 not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until superseded or modified."

Section 4. Adoption.

This ordinance being necessary to protect the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Multnomah County, and to continue the existing civil service rules until superseded or modified, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage pursuant to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.

ADOPTED this 27th day of February, 1975, being the date of its 1st reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
