

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR
MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON
ORDINANCE NO. 177

An ordinance relating to election of a commissioner for District No. 5.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. There shall be a special election for Multnomah County Commissioner Position No. 5, on April 3, 1979. The term of office of the successful candidate shall commence July 1, 1979, and end December 31, 1980.

Section 2. The election shall be held in the East District as described in section 5 of the 1978 amendments to the Multnomah County Home Rule Charter relating to Reorganization of County Commission referred to as Ballot Measure 26-15.

Section 3. Candidates for that election shall be those persons who have:

1. Resided in that district for more than 18 months prior to July 1, 1979;

2. Have been a qualified elector of Multnomah County for more than 18 months prior to July 1, 1979;

3. Who have filed on or before February 27, 1979, with the Director of Elections of Multnomah County a petition for nomination containing 250 validated signatures of qualified electors registered in the district.

Section 4. Notice of the election shall be published in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the district not more than 14 days prior to the election. The notice shall contain the date of the election, the location of polling places,

and a facsimile of the sample ballot.

Section 5. In addition to the notice prescribed in section 4, there shall be published in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the district prior to February 1, 1979, notice that contains the following:

1. Date of election;
2. Deadline for filing nominating petitions;
3. Location of forms for nominating petitions;


Section 6. The petition form shall be prepared by Director of Elections and shall contain no reference to any political party of the candidate. The petition may contain a statement of 12 words or less of any principles the candidate advocates or of the candidate's qualifications for office and such statements shall appear on the election ballot.

Section 7. The Director of Elections shall, within 10 days after the election, certify the results to the Board of County Commissioner of Multnomah County.

Adopted this 7th day of December, 1978, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.


