The purpose of the briefing is to update the Board of County Commissioners with about the SUN Service System. The SUN Service System is an aligned system of care providing social and support services that promote educational success and self sufficiency. The SUN Service System Coordinating Council provides system oversight and support to the SUN Service System in order to ensure shared responsibility and coordination across the multi-jurisdictional collaboration. As such, the Council wants to ensure that the Board of County Commissioners has current information about its efforts. Four areas will be discussed.

First, the foundation for the SUN Service System – the policy direction and how this has manifested in service delivery and strong partnerships. Second, the charge and membership of the Coordinating Council that ensures that key funders and partners are making decisions together to grow and deepen the SUN System. This includes the current funding and leverage amounts that comprise the System. Third, the presenters will discuss the accomplishments of the System. Finally, a review of the anticipated work of the SUN Council over the next couple of years. These include promoting the vision that every school becomes a SUN Community School, the System’s upcoming Request for Proposals, Equity efforts, and the Communities Supporting Youth Collaborative, a partnership with Portland State University that is part of the broader Cradle to Career initiative.

This briefing does not impact program offers per se, but rather discusses elements of several service areas that are integral to the SUN Service System: 25145, 25147, 25149, 25151, 25154, and 25155.
