WHEREAS, the Regional Strategies Program was established by the Governor and the Legislature to assist economic development throughout Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Strategies Program requires counties and groups of counties to choose a key industry as the focus of their regional economic development strategy under the Regional Strategies Program; and

WHEREAS, the Counties of Multnomah, Tillamook, Clatsop, Washington and Clackamas joined together in the 1991-93 biennium to form the Oregon Tourism Alliance region and adopted tourism as the focus of their regional strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Strategies Program requires county governing bodies to oversee the development of strategies, and to adopt preliminary strategies prior to submission to the state; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Multnomah, Tillamook, Clatsop, Washington, and Clackamas have joined together as the Oregon Tourism Alliance region and developed a strategy for submission to the state; and

WHEREAS, the regional strategy developed by the Oregon Tourism Alliance region meets the requirements of the Regional Strategies Program; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County has held the required two public hearings and has approved regional strategy focus;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of Multnomah County hereby adopt in its entirety the Preliminary Regional Strategy Document developed by the Oregon Tourism Alliance region and recommend that it be submitted to the Oregon Economic Development Department for funding consideration through the Regional Strategies Program in the 1991-93 biennium.
