FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON

ORDINANCE NO. 663

An ordinance amending Ordinance 596 by expanding the membership of the Policy Development Committee, making the Policy Development Committee advisory to the Board of Commissioners, and related organizational changes.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Findings.

A. Ordinance 596 established a Policy Development Committee, composed of the Board of County Commissioners and established the committee's duties regarding strategic planning for the County.

B. The Policy Development Committee now includes other elected officials, department managers and the executive assistant to the County Chair.

C. The expanded committee makes policy and other recommendations to the Board since only the Board of County Commissioners has authority to make policy decisions for the County.

D. The Board now desires to amend Ordinance 596 to reflect the expanded committee and its revised role.

8 policies related to the direction, planning and funding of programs
9 and operations of the County to the Board of County Commissioners.

14 Strategic Plan.

18 The committee shall consist of the Board of County Commissioners,
19 District Attorney, Sheriff, department managers and the executive
20 assistant to the County Chair.

22 D. Section 4 (E) is amended to read:

24 The Committee may [pursuant to Section 3.70 of the Charter of
25 Multnomah County] appoint advisory and other subcommittees as it deems
26 appropriate.

1 E. Section 4 (G) (2) is amended to read:

3 Members may [not] appoint others to represent them on the Committee
4 but designees shall not have voting privileges.

6 F. Section 4 G (3) is amended to read:

8 The affirmative action of a majority of the committee members is
9 required for the Committee to take any action. [Actions shall be by
10 resolution.]
