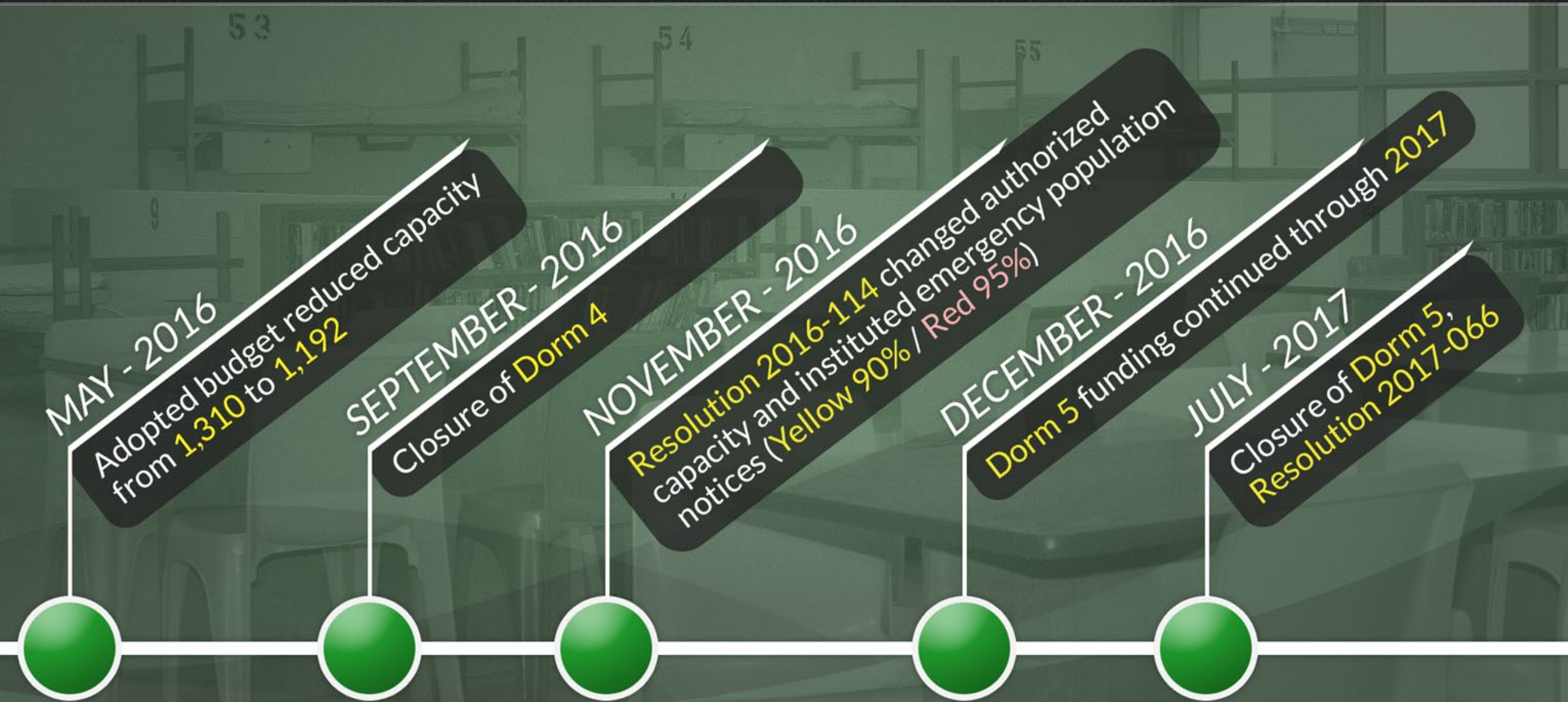
What is JCMP?

Jail Capacity Management Plan:

- Adopted pursuant to law, budget and jail operations
- Mitigates County jail population emergencies (95% of capacity)
- Forced release procedures based on risk to community safety
- Partners recommended amending release criteria and scoring

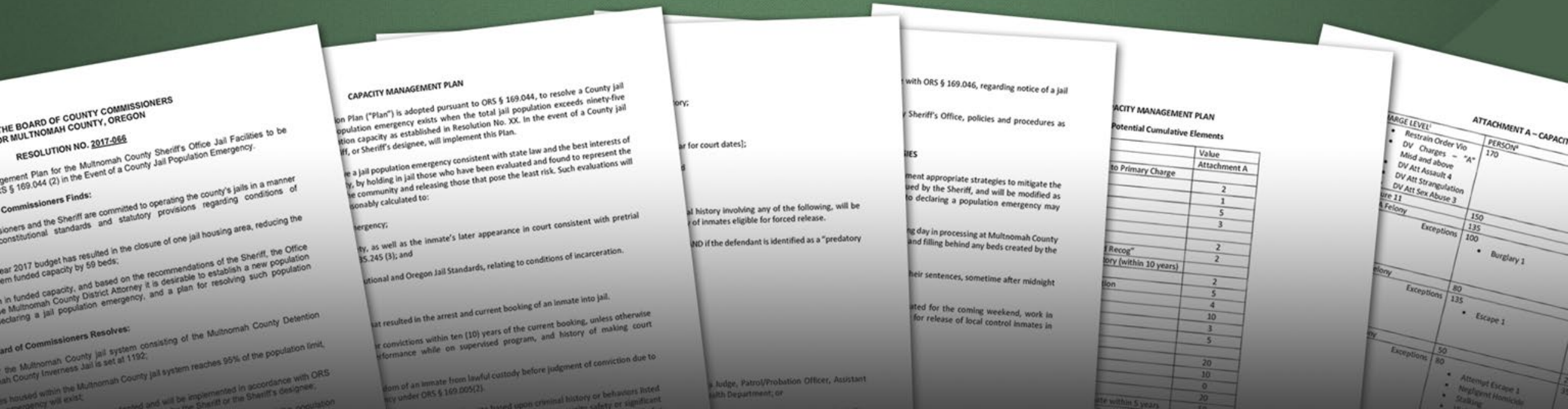

Workgroup Recommendations

- Ballot Measure 11 and Domestic Violence Crimes ineligible for forced release
- Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (UUMV) a special consideration
- Modified scoring of criteria based on recommendations
- Included DCJ reporting provision on Force Release Agreements



Where We Are Going...

Multnomah County practices strategies designed to:

- Divert individuals to treatment and break cycle of recidivism
- Stabilize individuals through continuum of care
- Facilitate coordinated return to community

Forced Releases impacts our efforts and our partnerships:

- 48 individuals were released while housed in the Treatment Readiness Dorm
- 79 individuals were released while a part of the Multnomah County Justice Reinvestment Program
- Individuals have told us forced releases hurt their recovery

Recommendation:

- Do not count Justice Reinvestment Program individuals in authorized capacity
- Fund MCJRP Dorm with other revenue sources
- Enables safe population management throughout facilities
