**Amending MCC Chapter 7 – County Management, § 7.008 – Assessment and Taxation Fees.**

**Multnomah County Ordains as Follows:**

**Section 1.** MCC § 7.008 is amended as follows:

**§ 7.008 - ASSESSMENT, RECORDING AND TAXATION FEES.**

(A) For any printout or copy of an appraisal card for any tax account, the Division of ~~a~~Assessment, Recording and taxation ~~Taxation~~ shall charge a fee as set by Board resolution.

(B) For the division's services in gathering, preparing or providing nonstandard information upon request, the division shall collect a fee equal to its actual cost, as determined by the director of the division.

(C) In addition, the division shall charge as set by Board resolution for copies provided by it.

(D) For a passport photo, the division shall charge a fee as set by Board resolution.

(E) For a waiver of the marriage three-day waiting period, the division shall charge a fee as set by Board resolution, as authorized in ORS 205.320(9).

(F) For processing an amendment to a marriage license or state domestic partnership certificate, the division shall charge a fee as set by Board resolution, as authorized in ORS 205.320(9).

(G) The division shall charge a filing fee for a Board of Property Tax Appeal, as set by Board resolution.

(DH) For any check, draft or order of payment in money given to the division by any person in payment of taxes or fees for any service provided herein above, which check, draft or order of payment in money is dishonored for any cause, including but not limited to nonsufficient funds, closed account or no account, there shall be a fee assessed as provided at § 7.002. The fee is collectible by the division in any lawful manner, including but not limited to, addition of the fee to the payer's tax account, filing of appropriate proceedings pursuant to statute or such other means as may legally be pursued.
