General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

It is recommended that the Multnomah County Library District Board adopt the budget for Fiscal Year 2017. At the time of the adoption, the MCLD Board can incorporate amendments that reduce the budget by any amount or increase the fund up to 10%.

Adoption of the budget sets the upper limit on library district spending during the next year. One proposed revenue amendment and one program amendment will alter the spending plan in the approved budget. The MCLD Board has had an opportunity to review and discuss these amendments.

Adopting the budget sets the legal limits for spending during Fiscal Year 2017 and is required to comply with Oregon Budget Law.

The Tax Supervising Conservation Commission (TSCC) hearing on the Approved Budget took place on May 18, 2016. There were no recommendations or objections to the FY 2017 Approved Budget.
