

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
FOR MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON  
ORDINANCE NO. 302

An Ordinance establishing a County/City Task Force on Special Housing Needs.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1.

There is hereby established a joint Multnomah County and City of Portland Task Force on Special Housing Needs.

Section 2.

The Task Force shall be composed of fifteen (15) members, recommended to represent the following groups: 1 member from MCCA Housing Policy Committee; 1 member from Housing Authority of Portland; 1 member from Metropolitan Human Relations Commission, Housing Committee; 1 member representing the realty sector, 1 member from the Housing Task Force (Multnomah County Housing Policy Committee); 1 member from the City of Portland Housing Advisory Committee; and 9 members from the Special Needs categories. It is understood that eight (8) members of the Task Force shall be appointed by the City of Portland. The remaining seven (7) members shall be appointed by the County of Multnomah according to the Home Rule Charter.

Section 3.

The Task Force shall prepare a report and recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners and the Council of the City of Portland which defines the types of populations and particular problems associated with those people who are generally referred

to as having Special Housing Needs; the Task Force is further directed to examine the adequacy of existing resources; and, the Task Force is further directed to recommend policies and procedures designed to meet the housing needs of those populations which are not now being met. The focus will be on any licensing or code-related issues which directly impact the provisions of housing opportunities of special needs populations.

Section 4.

Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the City of Portland Office of Housing Policy. Technical assistance on an as needed basis will be provided by the County Department of Human Services. Such staff assistance shall be provided for a period of not to exceed six months.

Section 5.

The Task Force shall make a report to the City and County by August 31, 1982.

Adopted this 1st day of April, 1982, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
