WHEREAS Senator Wayne Morse, while Dean of the University Law School turned said institution into one of the more respected Law Schools on the West Coast; and,

WHEREAS while serving Oregon in the United States Senate, Wayne Morse served as Republican, Independent and Democrat, honoring the finest qualities of each by putting principal above party; and,

WHEREAS Senator Wayne Morse to date has no public memorial to commemorate his lifelong dedication and service to the nation and to the state and people of Oregon; and,

WHEREAS the Wayne Morse Memorial Committee has asked that the Fremont Bridge be renamed the Senator Wayne Morse Bridge in order to commemorate his lifetime of service.


