National Coming Out Day is recognized internationally as a day of self affirmation and awareness of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) issues. It was founded in 1988 to celebrate the second National March on Washington for Lesbian and Gay Rights in 1987, in which 500,000 people marched on our Nation's Capital to raise awareness of and garner support for the LGBTQ community.
