

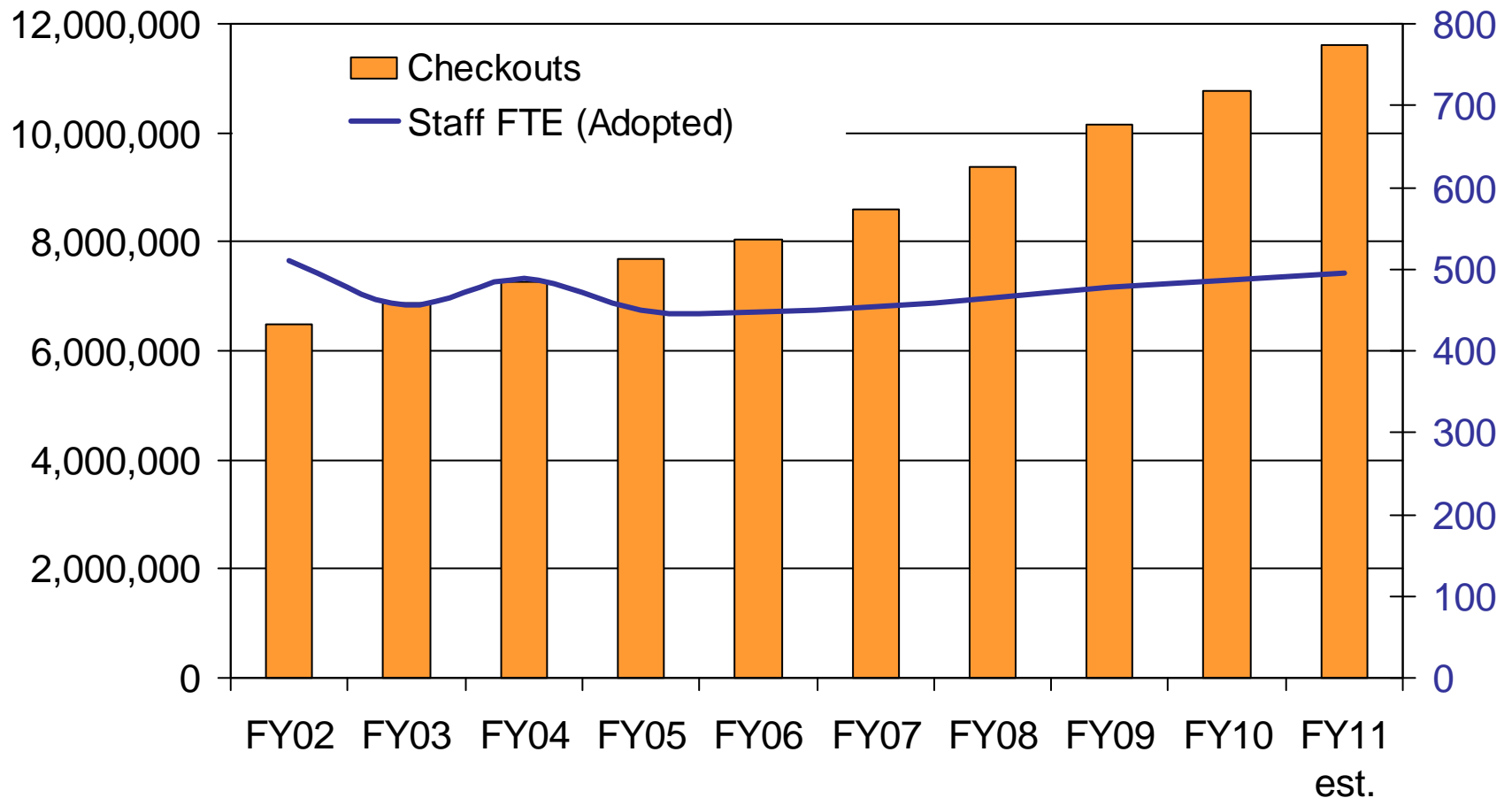

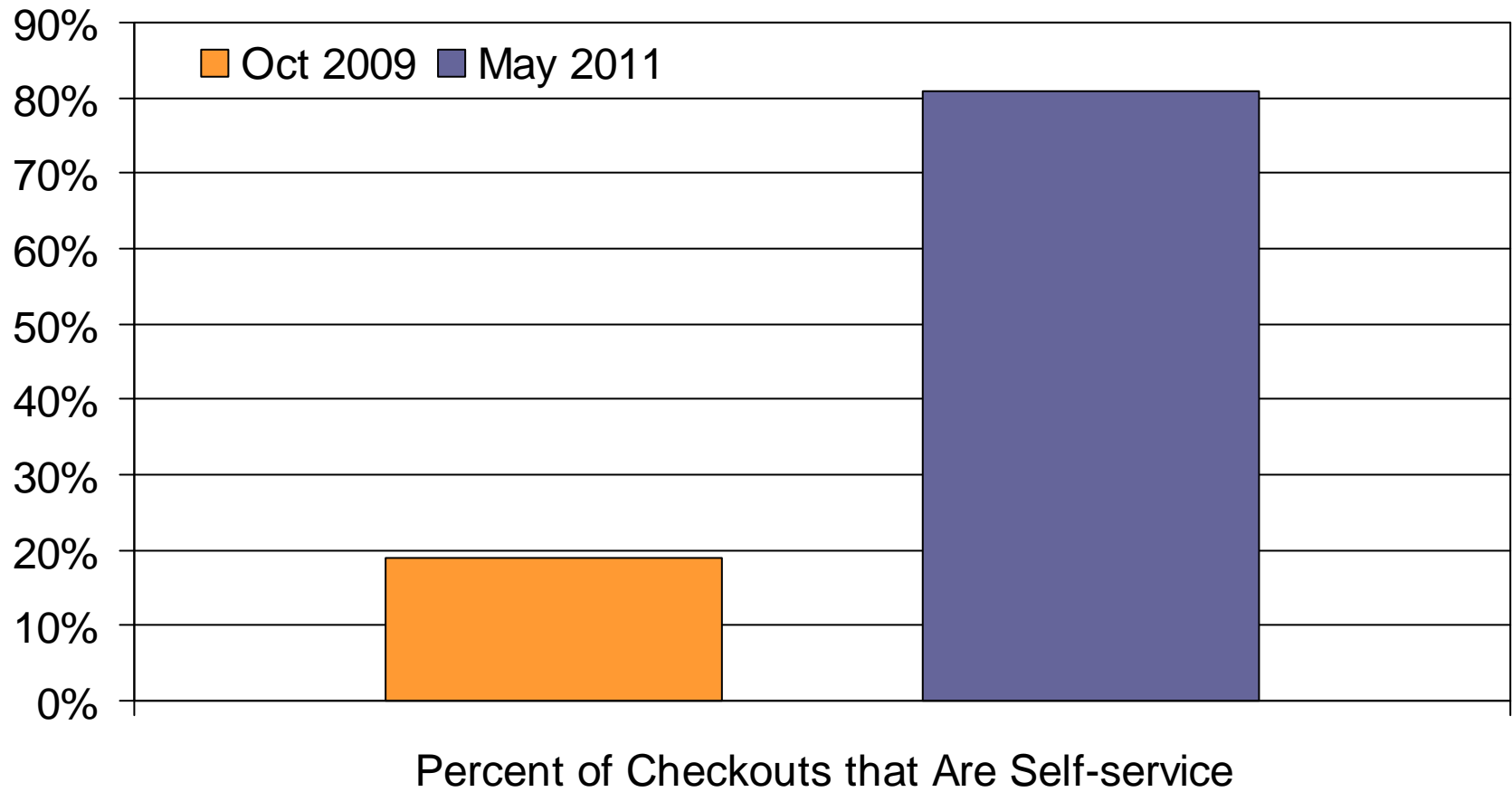

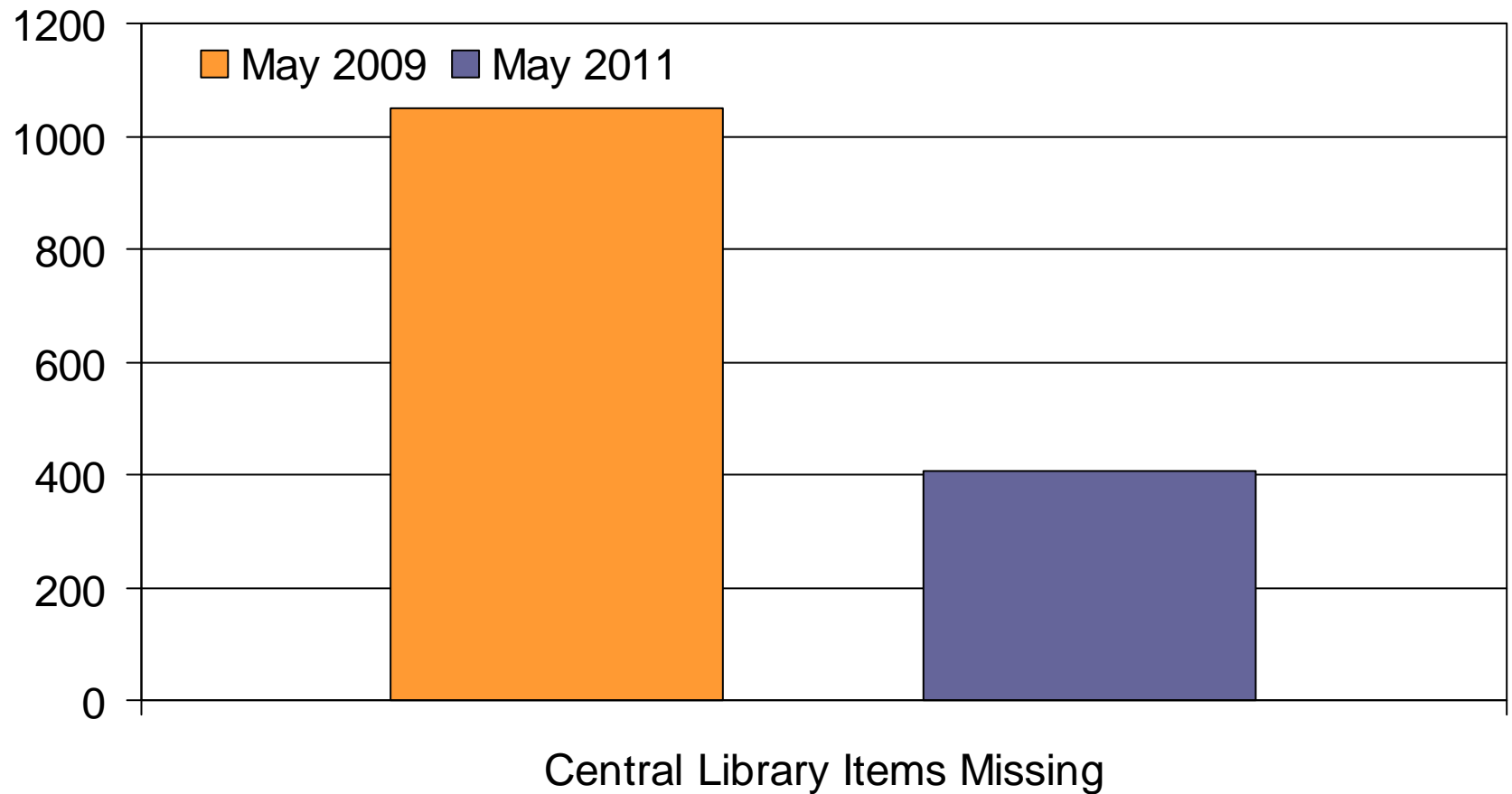
MCL Staff Members Show Patrons How to Use the RFID Checkout Stations at the New Troutdale Library
