ORDINANCE NO. 310

An Ordinance establishing a special Task Force to review
Multnomah County Sting Operations.

Multnomah County Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Policy and Purpose. The Board of County
Commissioners finds that there is a need to establish appropriate
standards for the use of "Sting" operations by the Multnomah
County Sheriff's Office.

Section 2. Special Task Force on Sting Operations. A
Special Task Force on Sting Operations is established as an advisory
body to the County.

Section 3. Membership and Staff.

- A. The Task Force shall consist of eight (8) members
appointed by the County Executive and approved by the
Board of County Commissioners as follows:
1. The District Attorney;
 2. The Sheriff;
 3. A representative of the insurance industry;
 4. A representative of the American Civil Liberties Union;
 5. A representative of the Metropolitan Public Defenders
Office;

6. A representative of the private bar;
 7. One citizen-at-large;
 8. The Director of the Department of Justice Services.
- B. At the first meeting of the Task Force, the members shall select its chairman from among its members.
- C. The Task Force shall be supported by staff of the Department of Justice Services.

Section 4. Powers and Duties of the Task Force. The Task Force shall:

- A. Review LEAA guidelines and Division of Public Safety procedures on sting operations.
- B. Recommend changes to the Division of Public Safety's guidelines and procedures.
- C. Report to the Board of County Commissioners by August 3, 1982.


