Adoption of resolution declaring the County's intent to extend the agreement for exclusive emergency ambulance service for two years.

The County has contracted with AMR for exclusive emergency ambulance service from 9/1/2005 through 8/31/2013. The program Offer is #4004 - Ambulance Services (EMS). The contract allows for extensions of up to two more years until 2015 in one- or two-year increments.


