RESOLUTION NO. 03-051

Support for Issuance of Industrial Development Revenue Bonds by the State of Oregon to Aero Portland, LLC for an Air Cargo Business Project at Portland International Airport

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. Business activity by Aero Portland, LLC at Portland International Airport would foster economic growth and legislative policy as set forth in ORS 285B.320.
- b. The Portland Development Commission supports the project, as it aligns with PDC's recently completed Economic Development strategy that specifically encourages the retention and expansion of distribution and logistics related businesses.
- c. The Portland Development Commission confirms that the property in question is zoned General Industrial, which is an appropriate land use designation for this site, and that it conforms to the Port of Portland's development plan for the airport.
- d. In compliance with ORS 285B.332, this Board finds that the project by Aero Portland, LLC in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, would be in the best interests of the citizens of Multnomah County.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:
