ORDINANCE NO. 240

An Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 226.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS.

- A. Ordinance No. 226 was enacted as an emergency ordinance on April 24, 1980, to establish interim standards and procedures for processing development proposals on land zoned EFU-38; MUA-20; CFU-38; and MUF-20, until the provisions of those zone districts are revised to comply with Statewide Planning Goals 3 and 4.
- B. The Planning Commission has passed resolutions and recommended draft ordinances to amend the above zone district provisions and the zoning map to comply with the Land Conservation and Development Commission Continuance Order and the said Goals.
- C. Upon the effective date of these zone district and map amendments, the need for Ordinance No. 226 will terminate.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 226.

Ordinance No. 226 is repealed on the effective date of Ordinance No. 236 (PC 12-80D/1), and Ordinance No. 238 (PC 12-80E/1).

ADOPTION

This Ordinance being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the people of Multnomah County, shall take effect on August 14, 1980, according to Section 5.50 of the Charter of Multnomah County.
