Human trafficking is the modern day practice of slavery. It comprises the fastest growing criminal industry in the world and every year traffickers generate billions of dollars in profits at the expense of millions of people around the world. The Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) in Multnomah County victimizes children in this community, with at least 469 cases identified in a recent study. This agenda item raises awareness about this issue and what Multnomah County is doing to combat it.
