ORDINANCE NO. 110

An Ordinance postponing the effective date of Ordinance 104; repealing Ordinance 107 and declaring an emergency.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Ordinance 104 to the contrary, the effective date of Ordinance 104 shall be November 6, 1975.

Section 2. Ordinance 107 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety by permitting time for review and preparation for implementation of Ordinance 104, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

ADOPTED this 2nd day of October, 1975, being the date of its first reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
