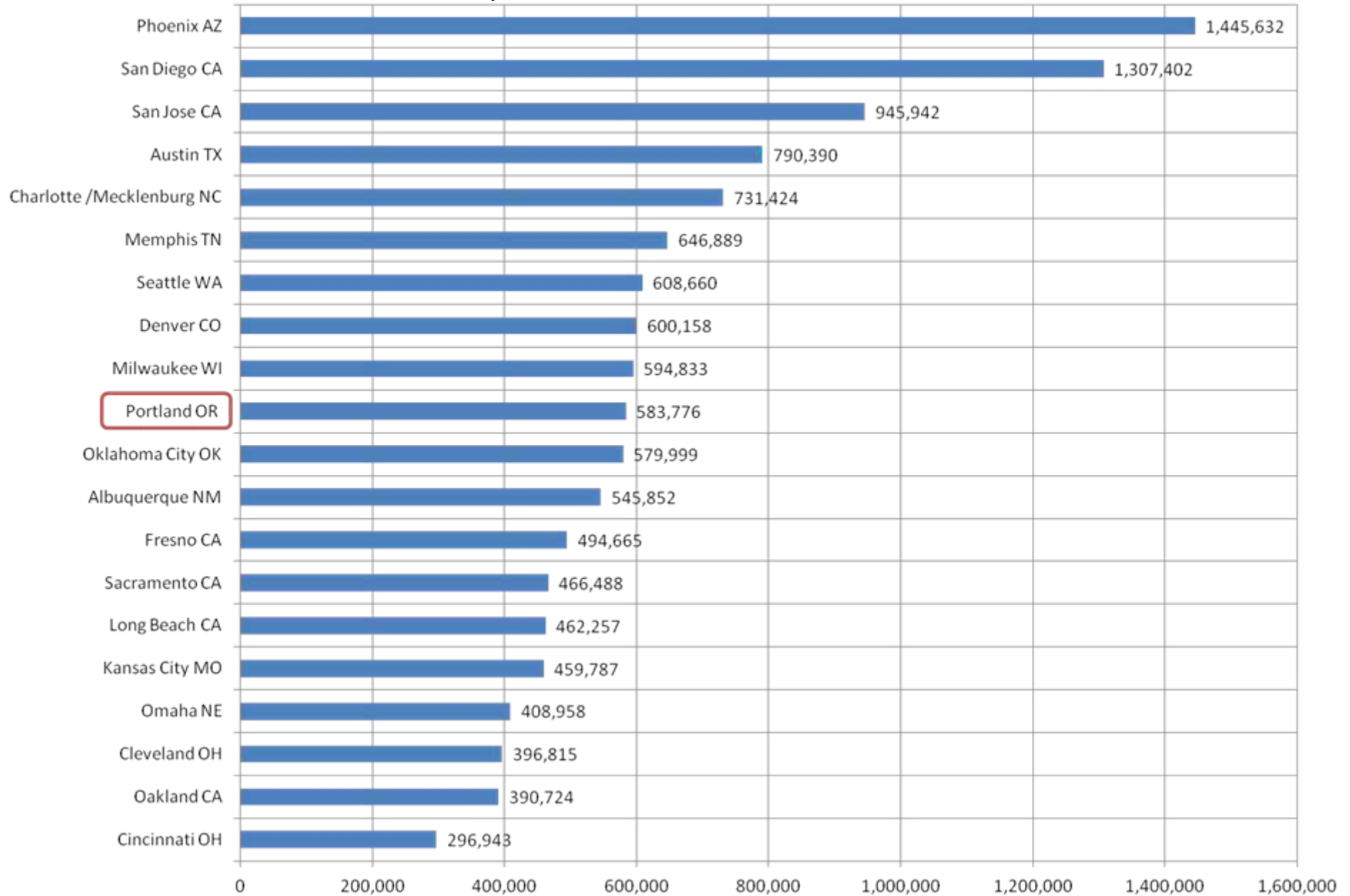

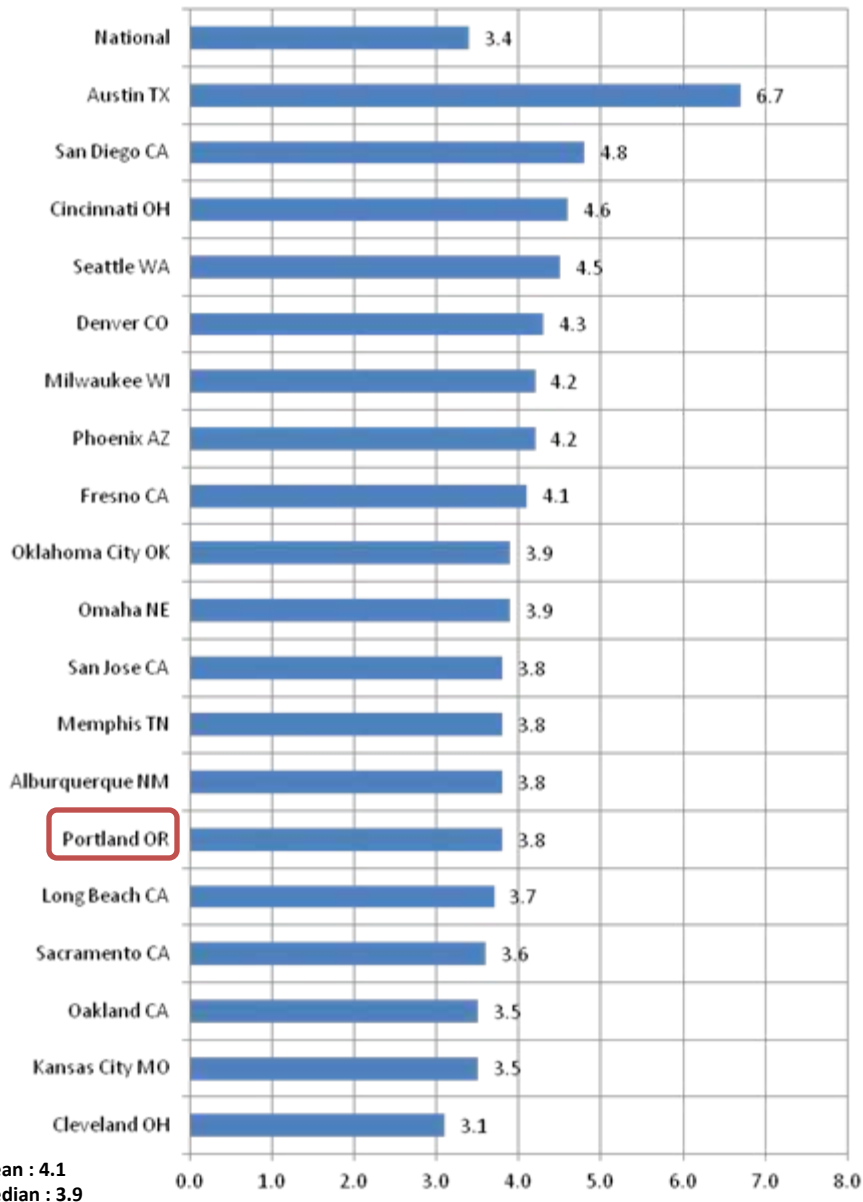

## Population: 2010 US Census Data

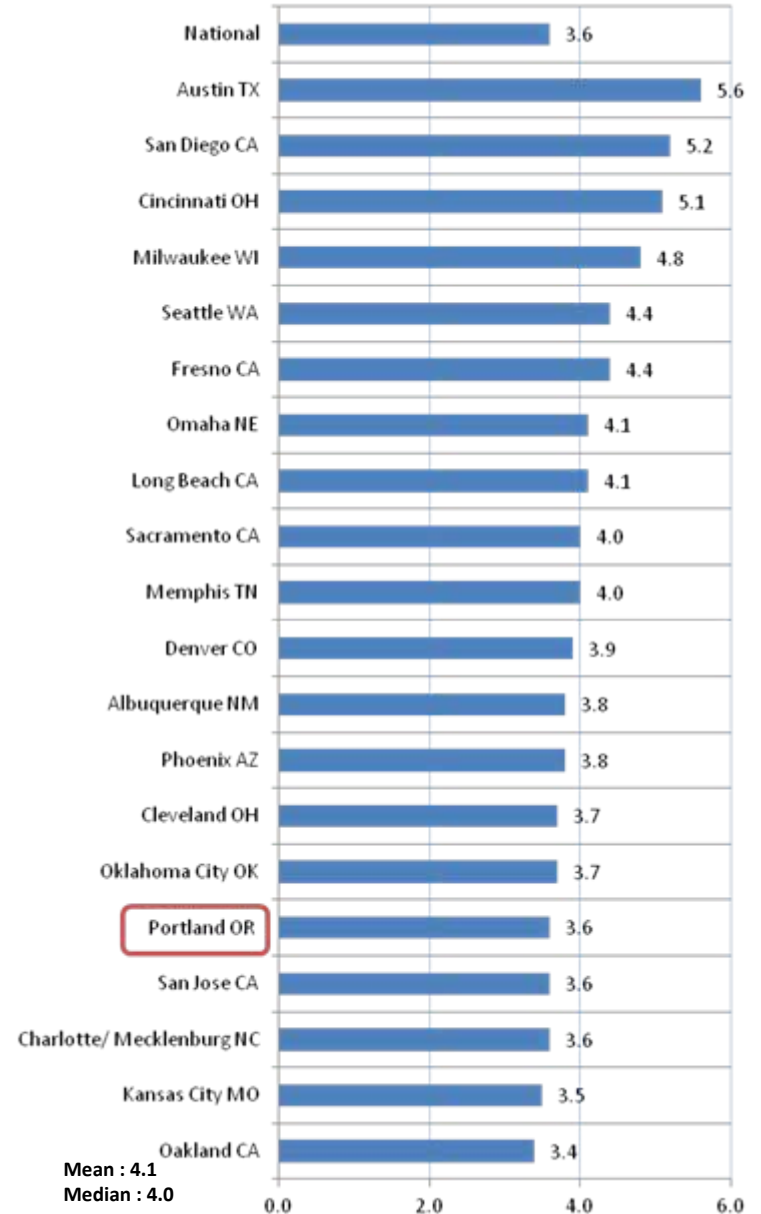


# Population Demographic – Percent Male 20 to 24

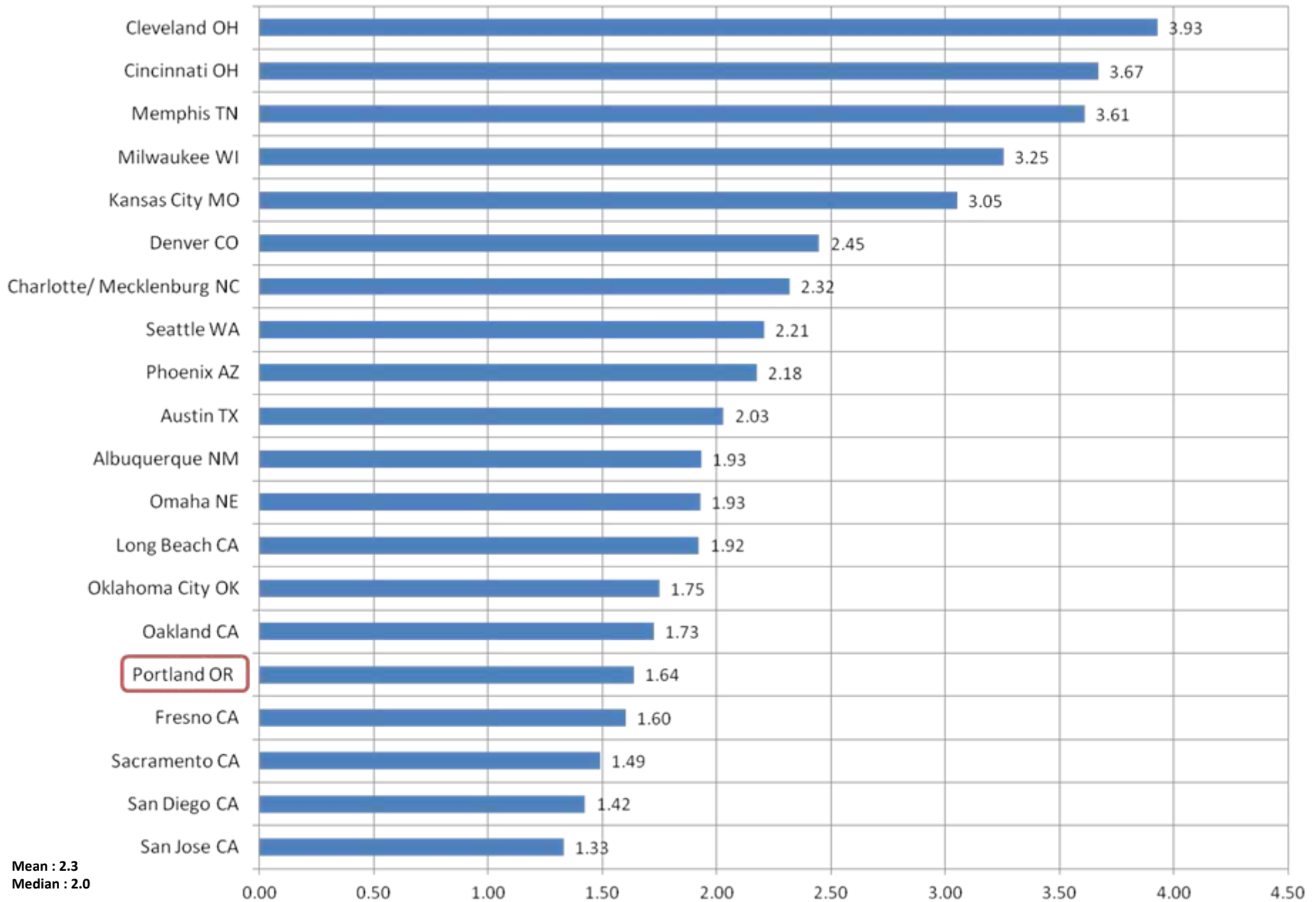
% Males 20 to 24: 2000



% Males 20 to 24: 2010

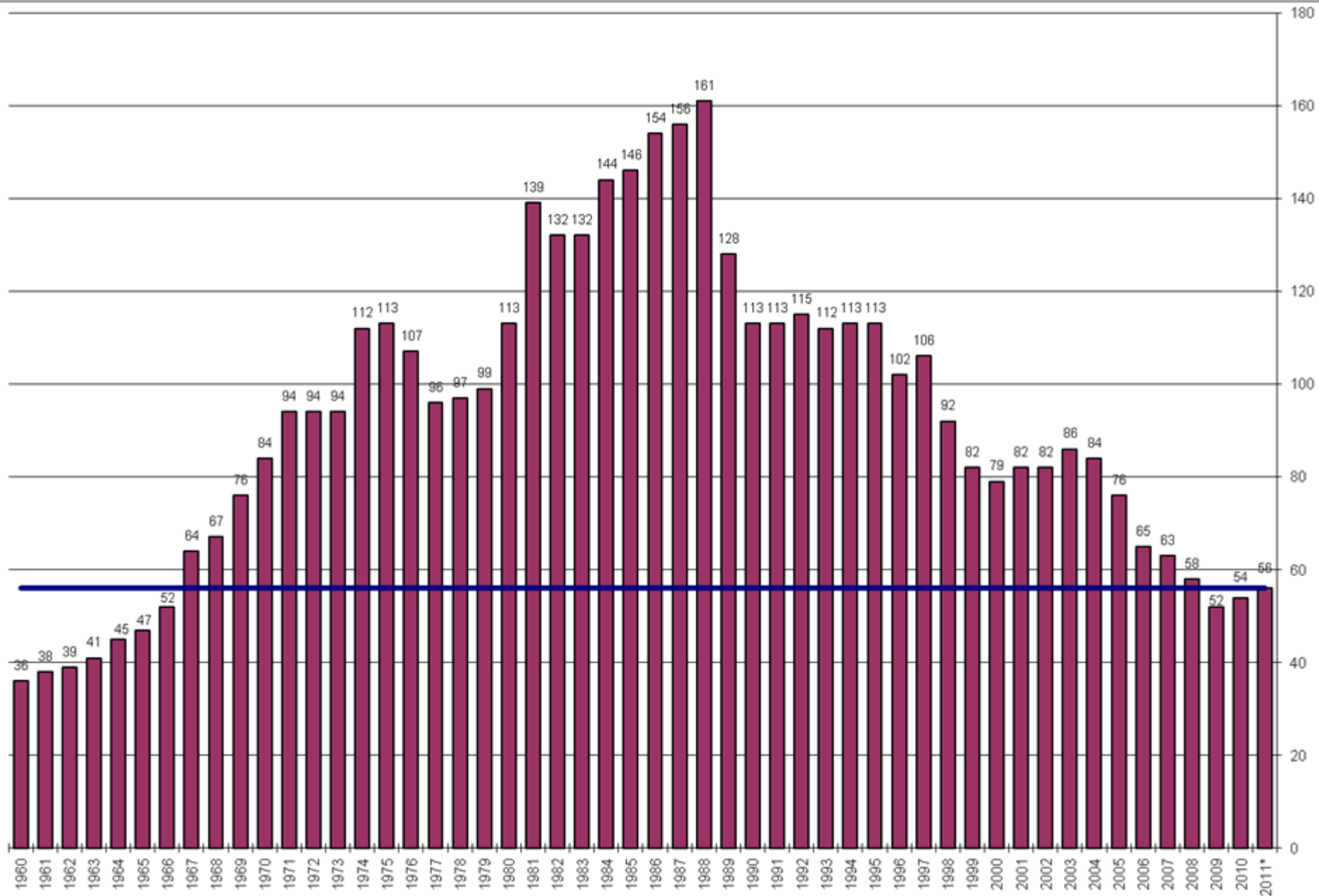


# Sworn Personnel per 1,000 Population



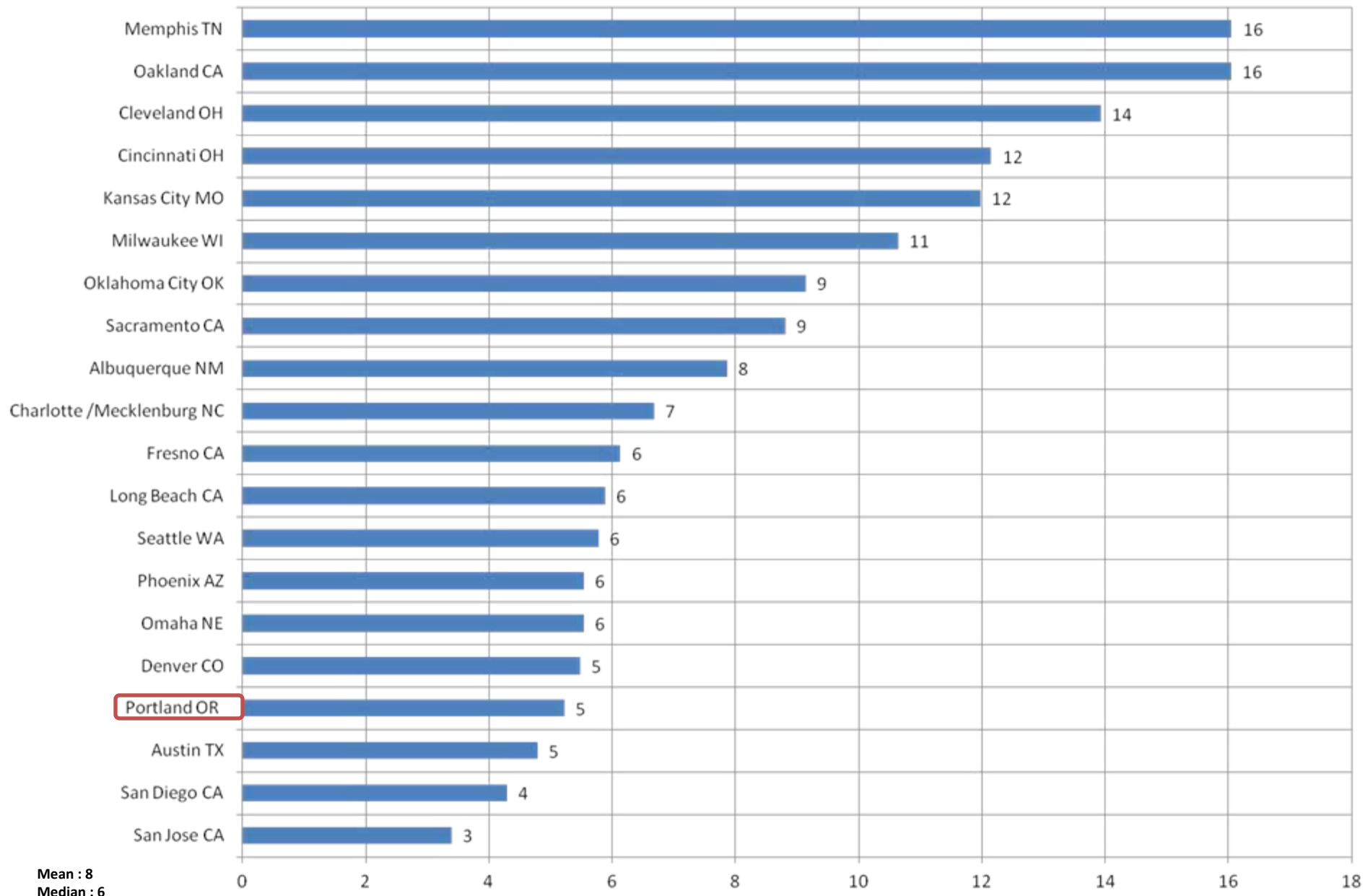

# Total Part I Crime Rate per 1,000 Population – Portland Oregon



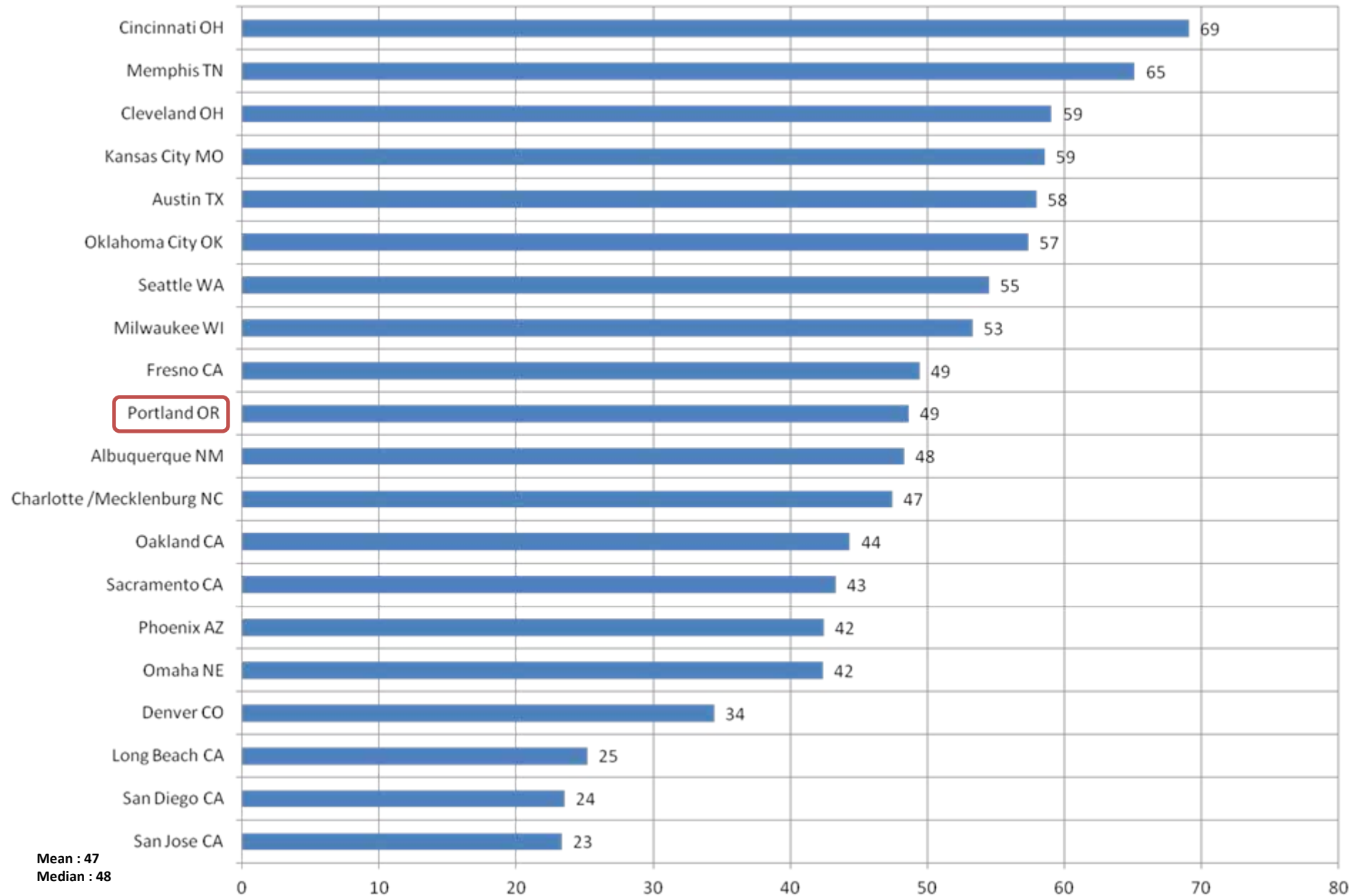

## Part I Person Crimes per 1,000 Population: 2010

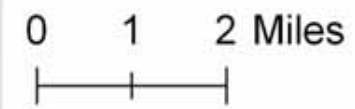

## Part I Property Crimes per 1,000 Population: 2010







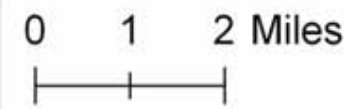

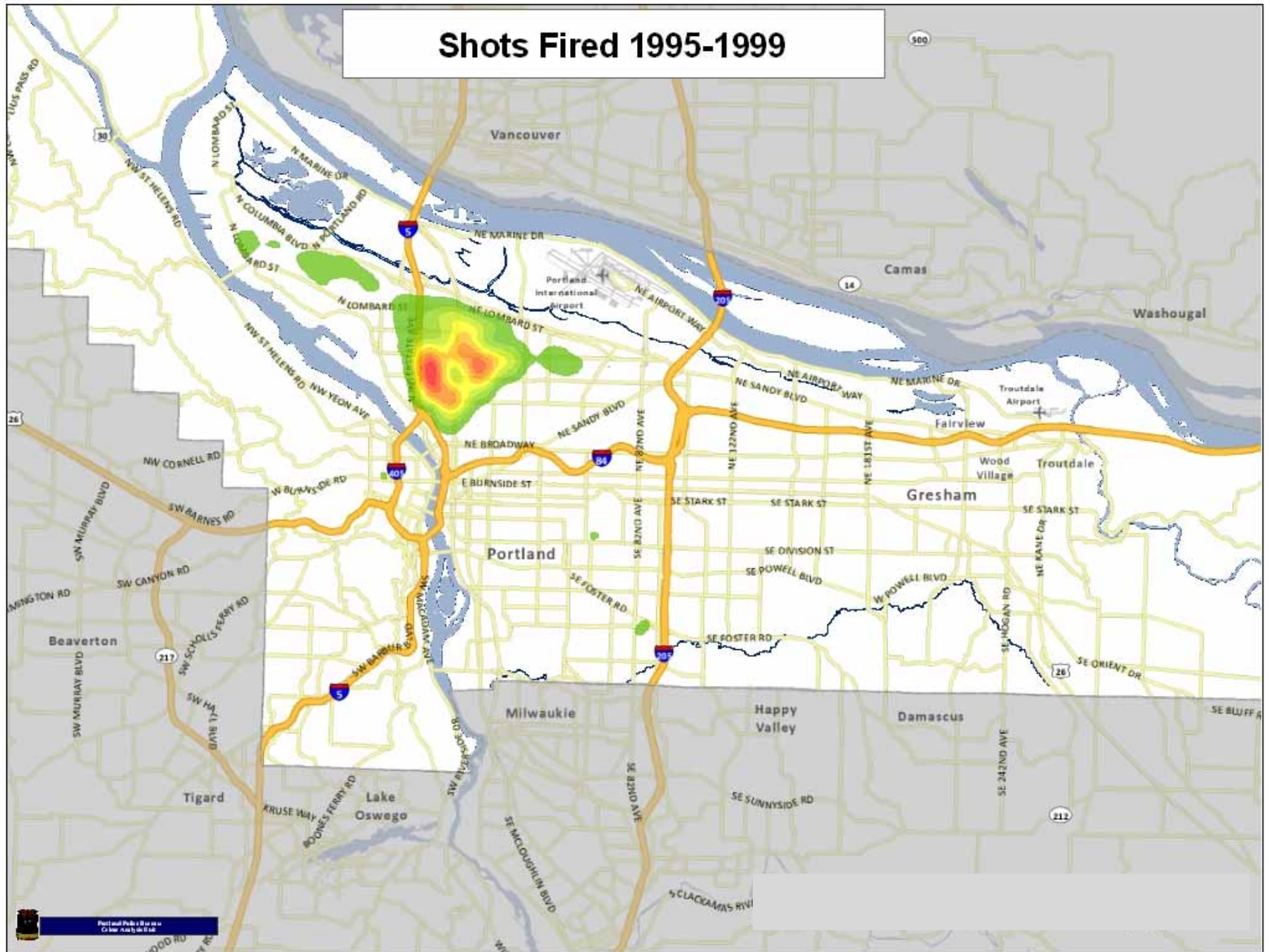

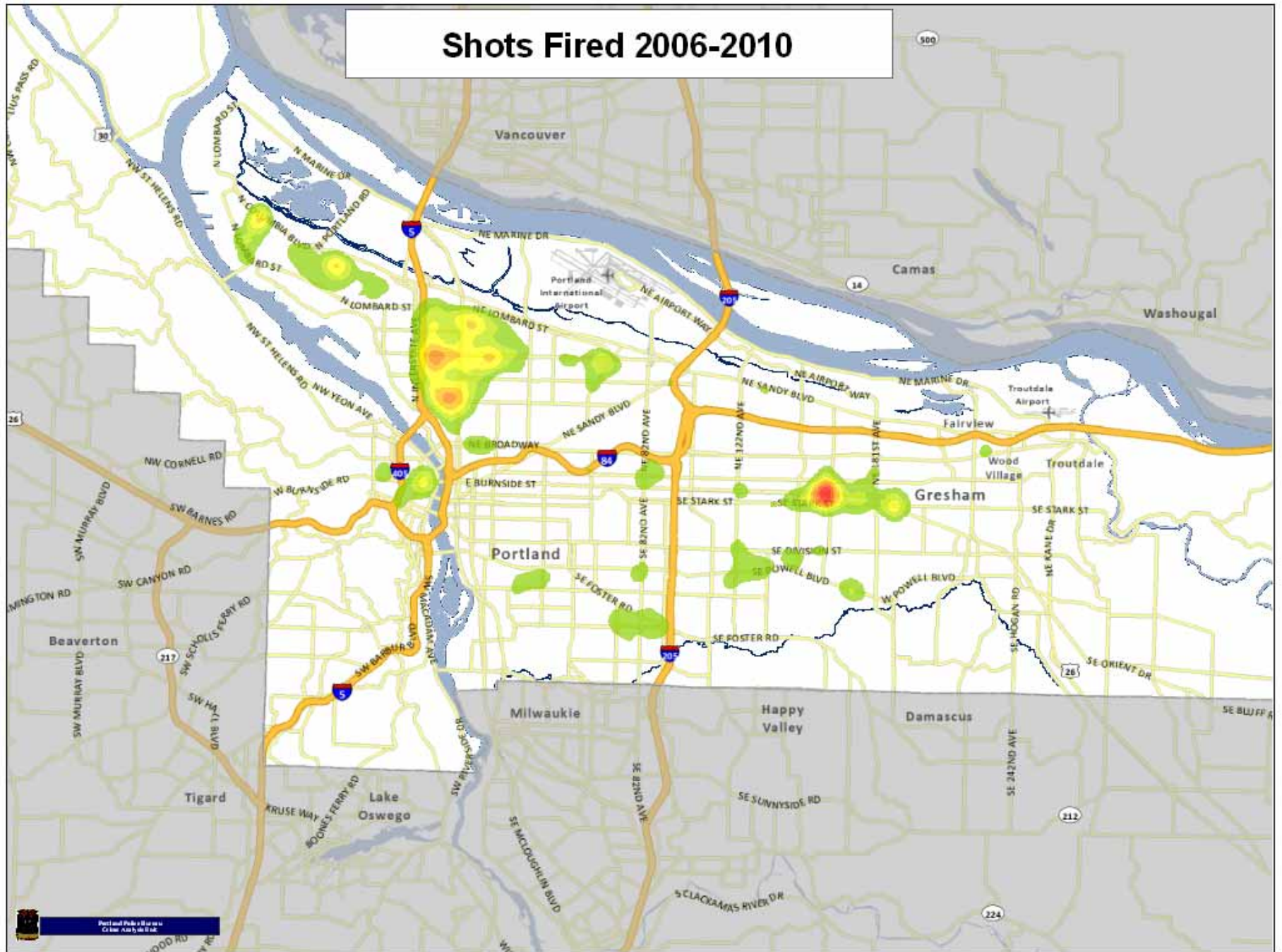

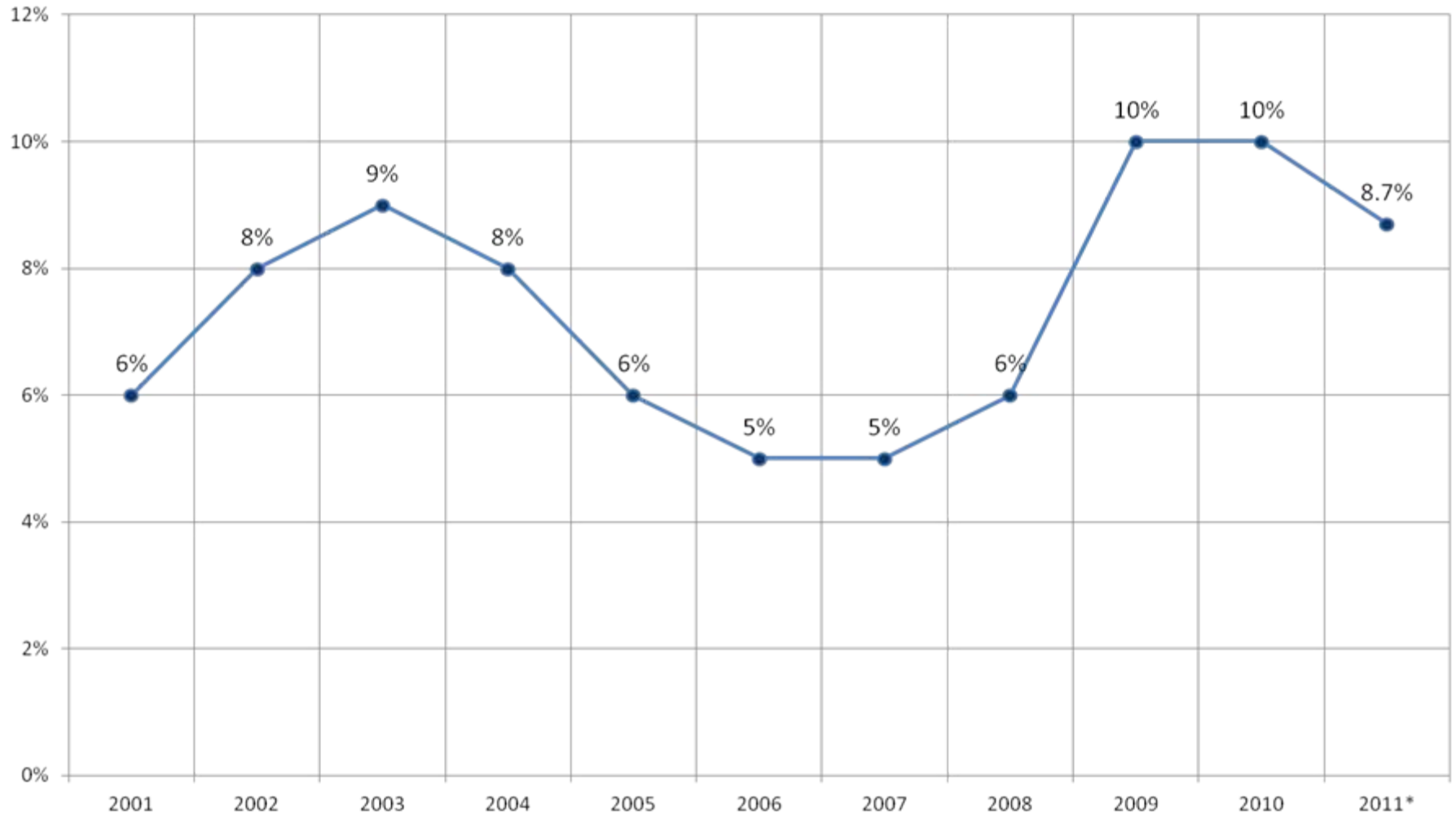

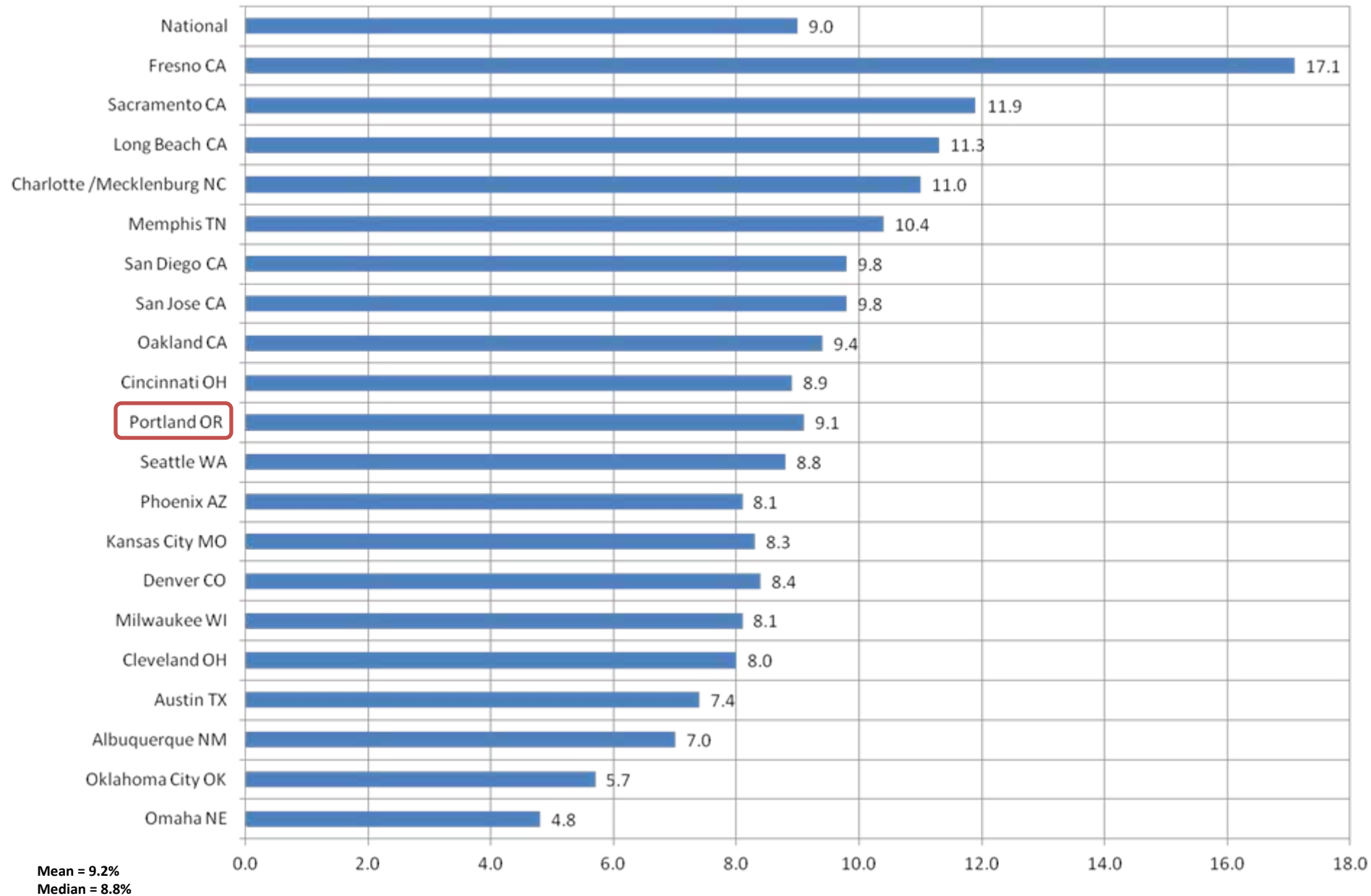

## Unemployment Rates: Portland Area per Year



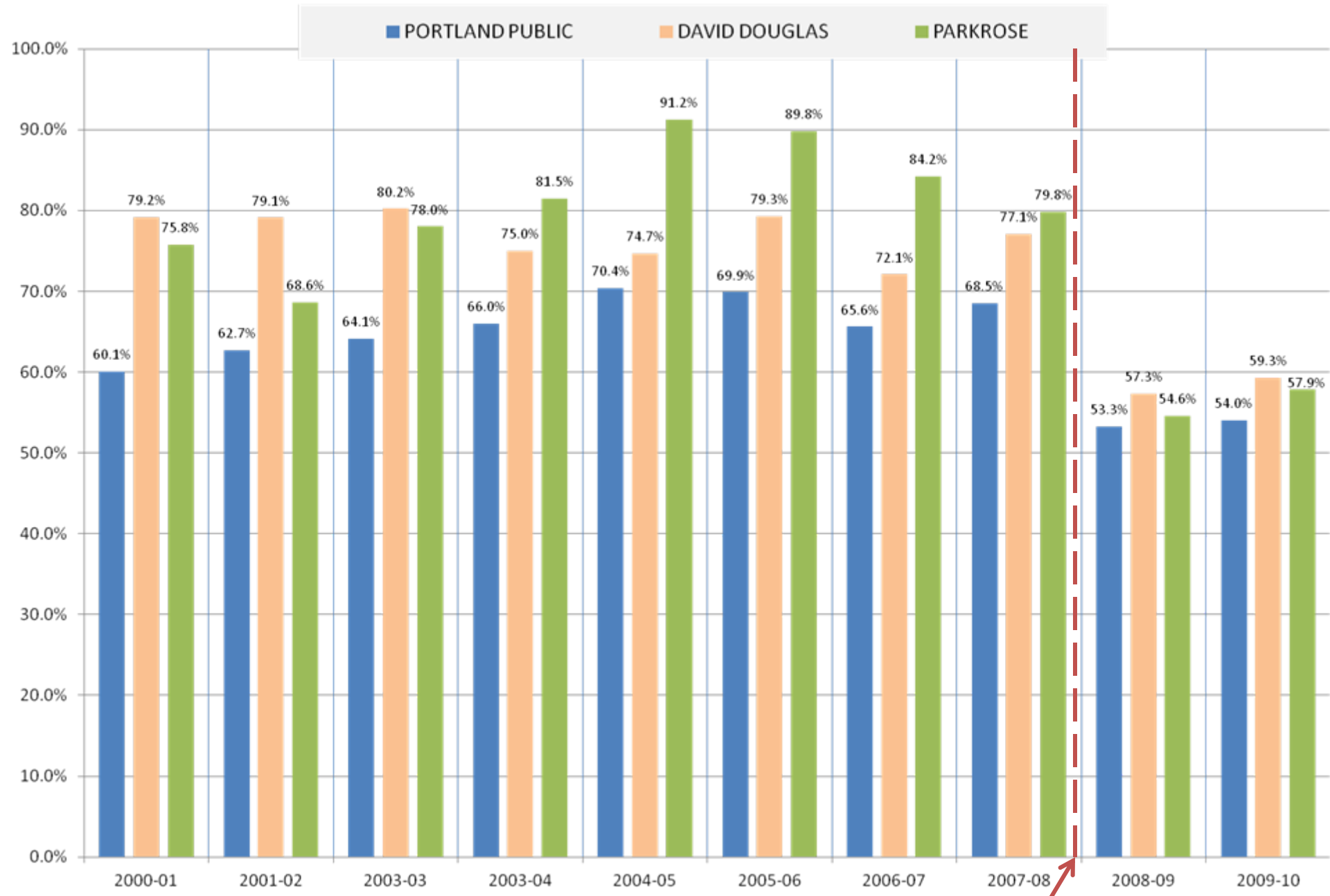


# Unemployment Rates per Metropolitan Areas: October 2011

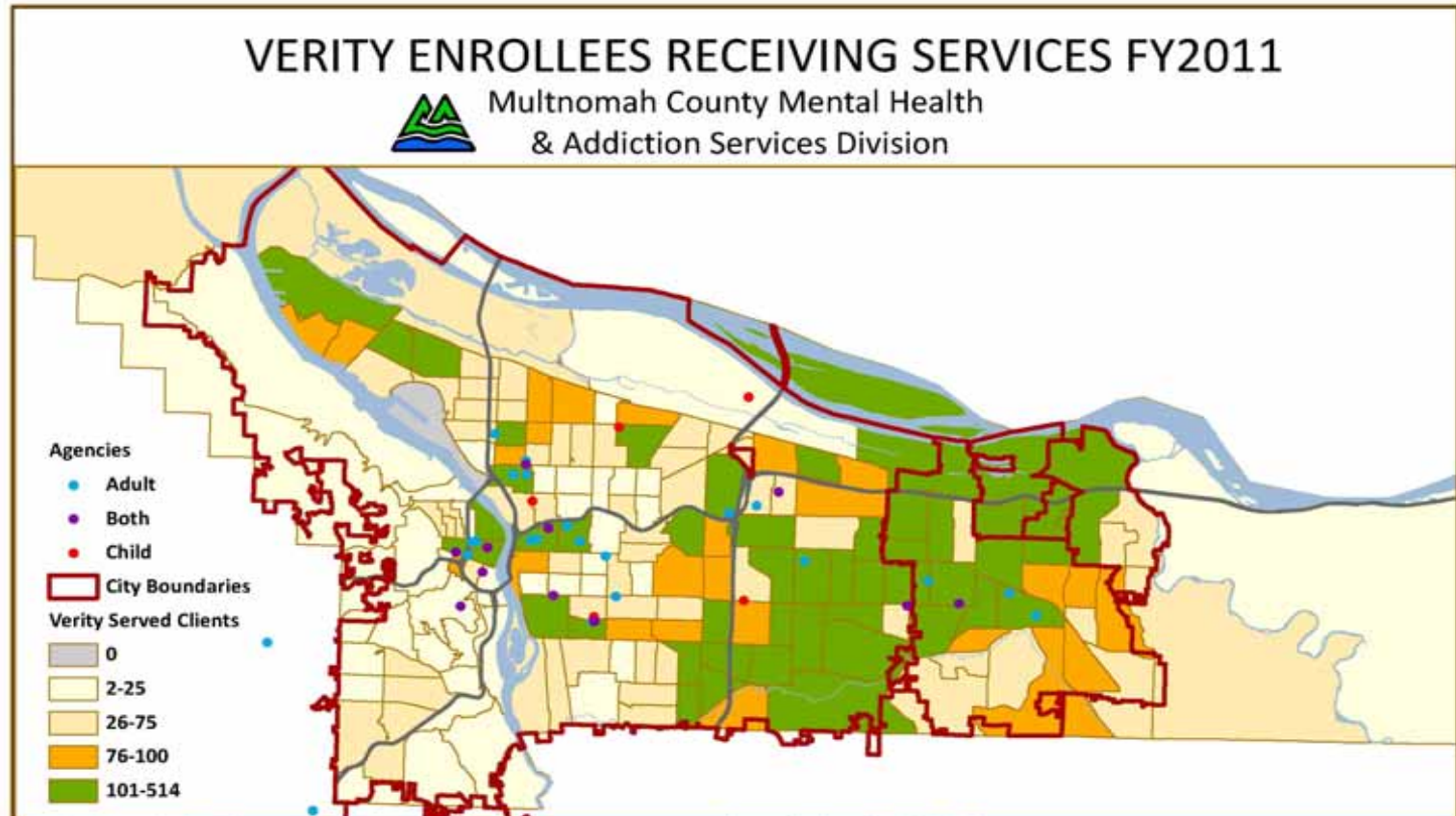

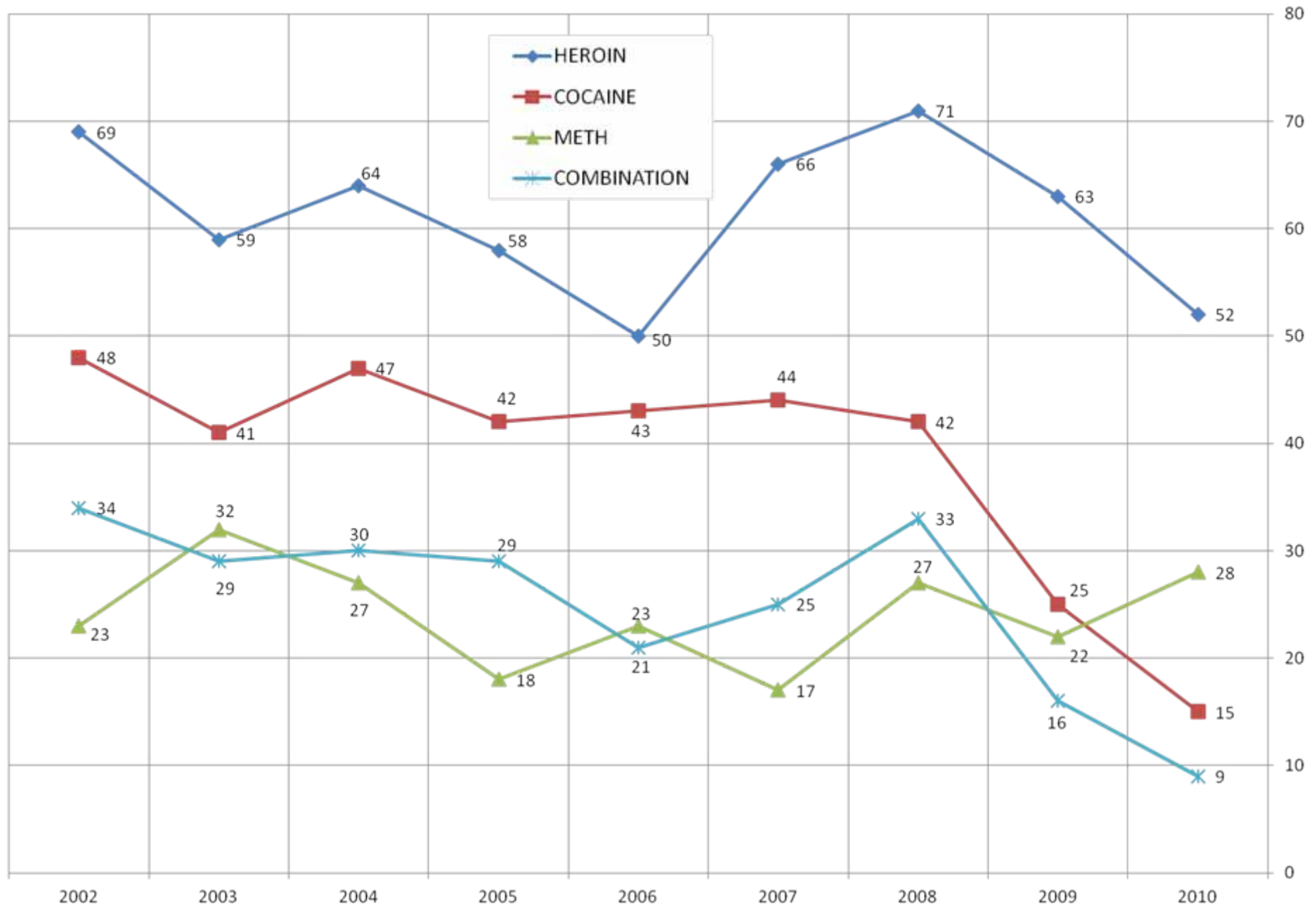

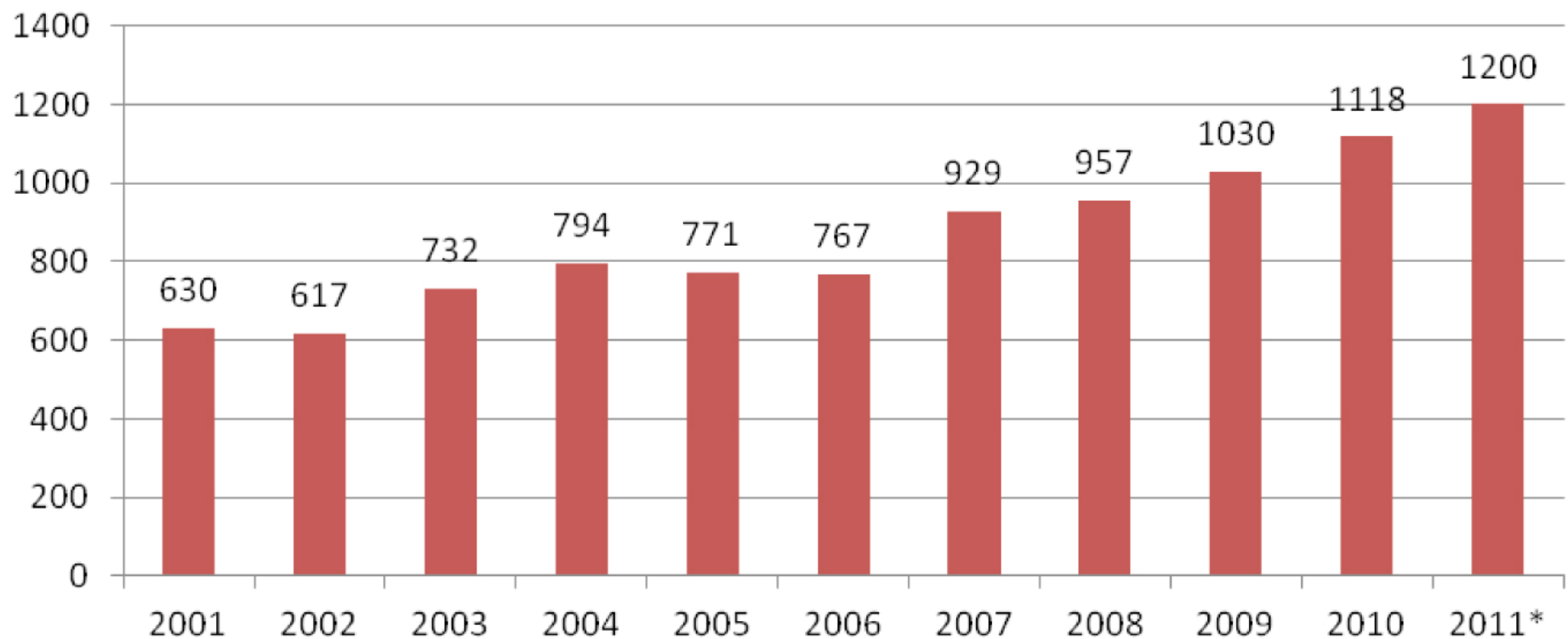
# Drug Overdose Deaths per Year



# Drug Overdose Related Deaths in Multnomah County – 2002 through 2010

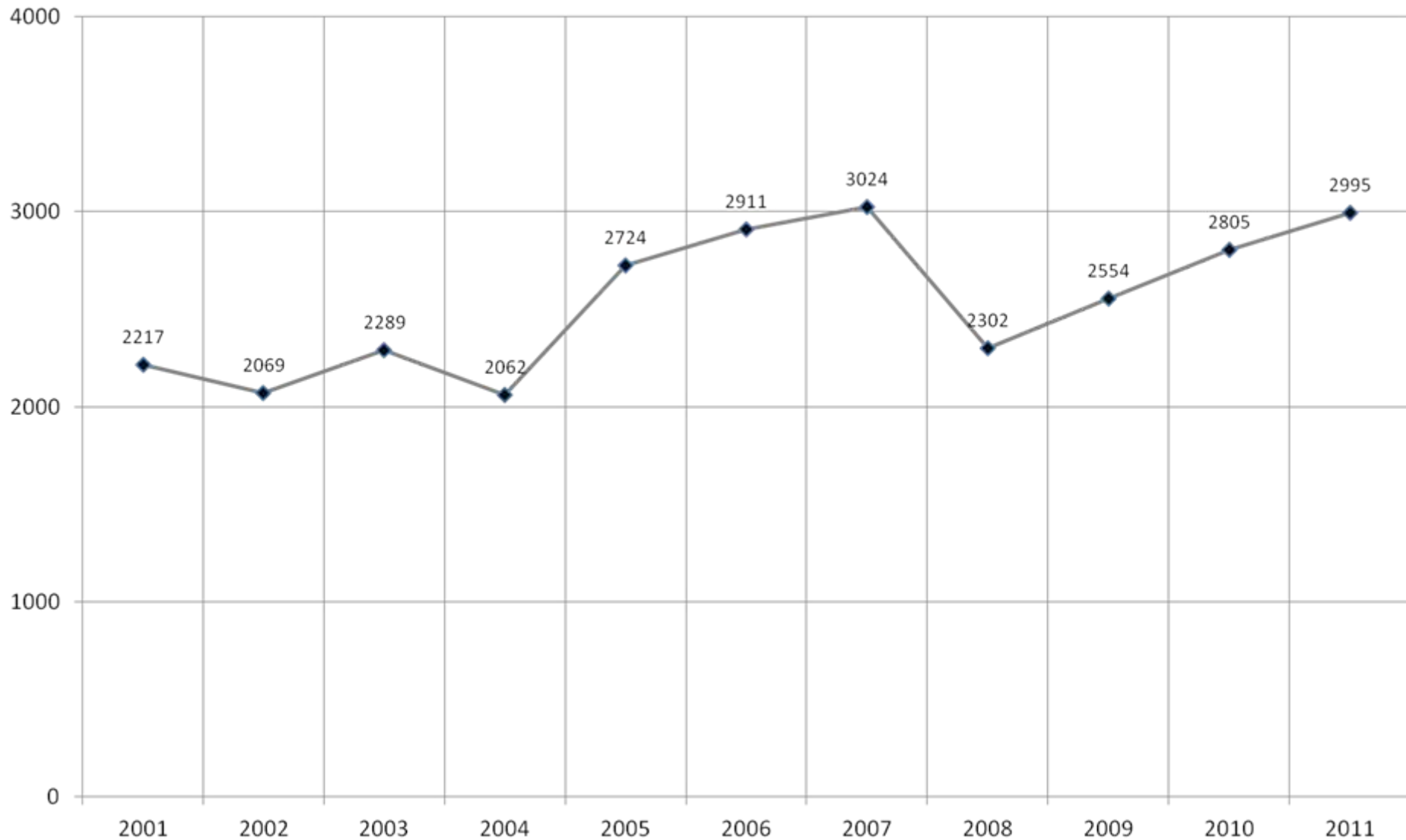


## Attempted or Threatened Suicide Calls



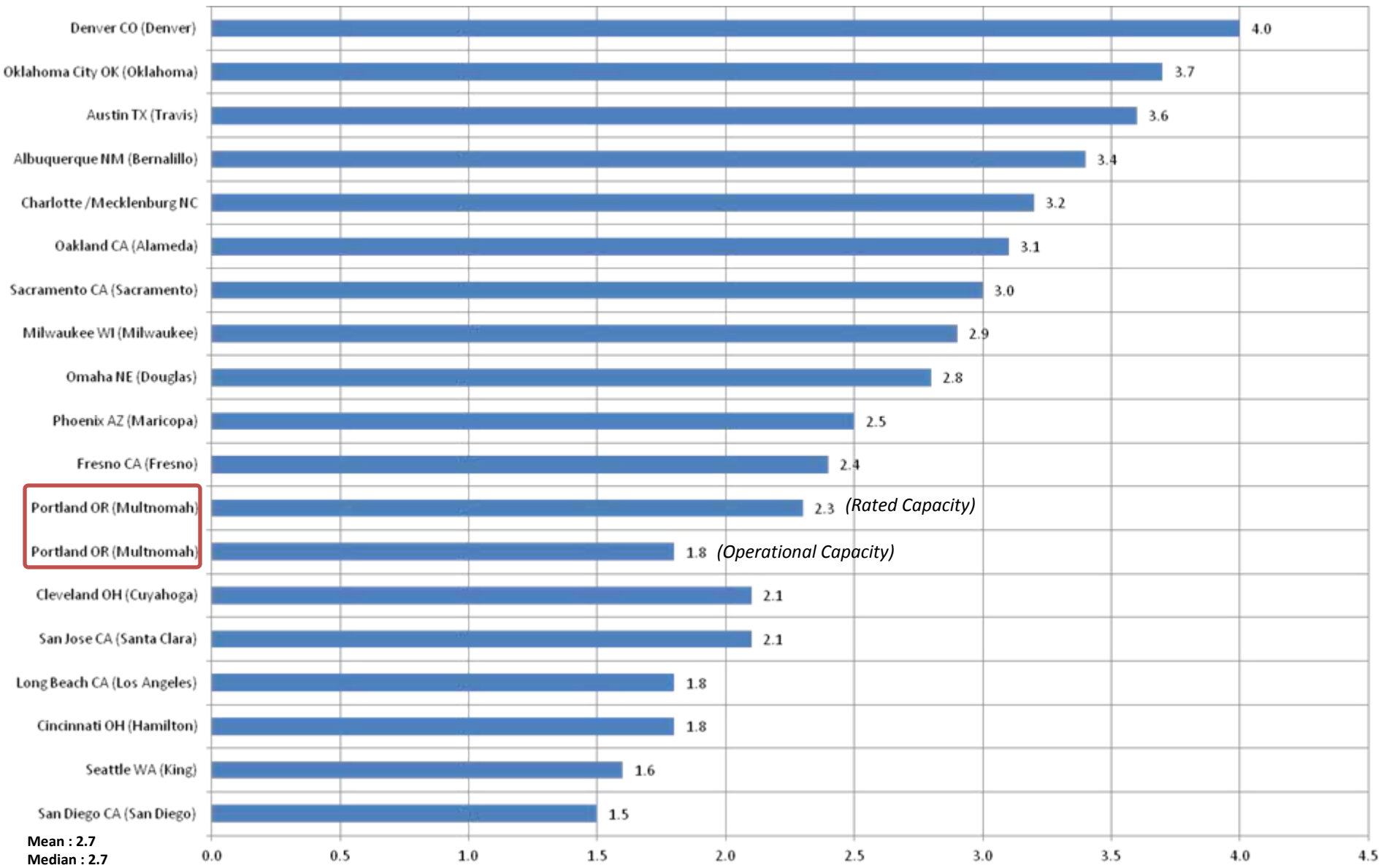

# County Jail Beds per 1,000 Population: 2010



\*Note Jail beds, Reported by the U.S. Department of Justice (BJS), Midyear 2010, and indicate the rated capacity assigned within each Jurisdiction. Exceptions include: San Diego County included the number of privately operated facilities. Cleveland OH Cuyahoga County Director of Corrections provided their capacity. Fresno CA's Sheriffs (Detention Bureau), provided their data for the capacity of Jail beds. Cincinnati OH Hamilton County data was obtained on-line and noted as Capacity of Jail beds as Court Limited. Portland Oregon(Multnomah) Operational Capacity of 1,310, and not included in the Mean or Median.
