**Authorizing Consent to Easement Agreement Relating to Multnomah County Sheriff's Willamette River Patrol Operations.**

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:**

- a. The Multnomah County Sheriff's Willamette River Patrol (WRP) has been operating from an Oregon Department of State Land Public Facility License adjacent to and accessed from real property located at the intersection of NW Front Avenue and NW 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Portland, Oregon (collectively, the "Site").
- b. The WRP desires to continue its operations from the Site because of its ideal location for the provision of the WRP's services.
- c. It is in the best interest of the public and Multnomah County to approve the Easement Agreement to lend certainty to the continuance of WRP operations from the Site.

**The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:**

1. The County Chair is authorized to execute the Easement Agreement in substantial conformance with the forms attached to this Resolution and to execute any additional documents necessary or desirable to further the intent of the attached documents, so long as such modifications or documents do not result in a material increase in the obligations of Multnomah County or a material decrease in the benefits for Multnomah County under the attached documents.
