Reason for Classification Decision:

This new position will be responsible for delivery of Nutritional and Medical benefits to people with disabilities and the elderly. The Case Manager 1 will provide ongoing case management services to eligible individuals; determining and documenting initial and ongoing eligibility for Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program and various Medicaid programs, completing required documentation and issuing benefits within required time frames. Additionally, this position will serve as advocate for the assigned clients by meeting their housing, transportation, mental health and other needs. This position is distinguished from the Eligibility Specialist (6300) classification by having assigned clients for whom needs assessments are conducted. This position requires education equivalent to the completion of twelfth grade and at least one year of experience working with clients of human/social service programs. The duties and requirements as described above best fit the Case Manager 1 (6298) classification.
