### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Seeking approval of an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) #29856 Amendment 1 with Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) that will allow ODOT environmental staff to conduct environmental investigation and associated documentation for the Sandy Blvd Improvements Project. The Amendment will also allow Multnomah County to select a consultant using the Direct Appointment consultant selection procurement process for Right of Way Services under the ODOT certification program.

### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

ODOT environmental staff has the knowledge and efficiency in conducting the specific environmental investigation ultimately needed for their review and Federal Highway Administration approval. This Amendment allows ODOT environmental staff to conduct the investigation and charge the project for their fees.

Additionally, ODOT has recently approved Multnomah County to conduct consultant selection on Federally funded projects when the estimated consultant fees are expected to be under \$100,000. This Amendment will allow the County to hire a Right of Way consultant under Multnomah County procurement rules.
