RESOLUTION NO. 98-130

Authorize the Multnomah County Aging and Disability Services Department to Co-Host the 1999 National Conference of the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging in Portland in July 1999

The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- a. The National Association of Area Agencies on Aging (N4A), a non-profit service organization representing more than 700 local area agencies on aging, will hold its annual meeting in the City of Portland in July 1999 with a projected attendance of more than 600 delegates.
- b. The Multnomah County Aging and Disability Services Department is an active member of N4A and is joining with other local and state agencies including the Washington County Aging Services Department, the Mid-Willamette Valley Senior Services Agency, the Oregon Association of Area Agencies on Aging, the Multnomah County Elders in Action, the Governor's Commission on Senior Services, the American Association of Retired Persons, the Oregon Senior and Disabled Services Division and the Southwest Washington Area Agency on Aging to implement the N4A National Convention.
- c. The 1998 National Association of Counties Annual Convention, the 1996 Government Finance Officers Association National Conference, as well as the 1992 National Organization of Black County Officials Convention were all successfully held in the City of Portland.
- d. The 1999 N4A will stimulate tourism as well as generate substantial revenue for tourist-related businesses in the City of Portland, the Portland-Vancouver metropolitan region and the State of Oregon.
- e. The 1999 N4A Conference will raise awareness for the important role that area agencies on aging play in maintaining and improving the quality of life for senior citizens in Multnomah County, the Portland-Vancouver metropolitan region and the State of Oregon.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Resolves:


