Authorization to dispose of the following abandoned vessels:

- 1) 1987 Hunter Marine 23-foot sail boat; OR 162PS
- 2) 1973 Crestliner 15-foot boat; OR 657VU
- 3) 1996 (homemade) 49-foot sail boat; OR 359ACH

The abandoned vessels have been left unclaimed on public waterways in Multnomah County. The Sheriff's Office River Patrol Unit has made attempts to contact the last known registered owners, but have been unable to locate anyone who will take responsibility for them. Destruction of these vessels is essential to protect the sensitive river ecosystem and discourage the dumping of unwanted vessels in the future.
