On June 25th, a new public art percent for art project was installed at the Multnomah Building, 501 SE Hawthorne. Walla Walla artist Wayne Chabre was selected in fall 2003 from a field of 120 applicants from across the country. The artwork was funded by Percent for Art dollars set aside in 1999 from the county's purchase and remodel of the Multnomah Building.

The bronze bas-relief panels flank the buildings entrance and represent the rural and urban communities as well as the industrial and business communities, reflecting the diversity found within Multnomah County.
