ORDINANCE NO. 26

An Ordinance providing for the exemption of the Citizens Affairs Coordinator, Department of Public Safety, from classified civil service and amending Article IV, Section (7), of Ordinance No. 10.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. Article IV, Section (7), of Multnomah County Civil Service Ordinance No. 10 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(7) Any special deputy sheriff or deputy constable appointed to act without compensation from the county, and the Citizens Affairs Coordinator, Department of Public Safety."

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
