ORDINANCE NO. 284

An Ordinance establishing a joint Multnomah County/City of Portland Citizen's Task Force on Alcoholism.

Multnomah County ordains as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established a joint Multnomah County and City of Portland Citizen Task Force on Alcoholism.

Section 2. The Task Force shall be composed of fifteen members; seven members to be appointed by the County Executive with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, seven members to be appointed by the City of Portland, one member to be appointed by the Burnside Consortium.

Section 3. The Task Force shall consider changes in the population of alcohol abusers and chronic alcoholics, the availability of and their access to various treatment options, the availability of or lack of new resources for alcoholics and the concerns of the community regarding alcoholism as they:

- a) Study the legal program and treatment issues involved in involuntary commitment of chronic alcoholics.
- b) Recommend changes in the laws affecting alcoholics.
- c) Make program recommendations to Multnomah County and to the City of Portland.

Section 4.

- a) The Task Force shall work with the Multnomah County Department of Human Services and appropriate bureaus within the City of Portland.

- b) The Burnside Consortium shall supply staff support to the Task Force.

Section 5. The Task Force shall make an interim report to the Board of County Commissioners and the Portland City Council during the first week of June, 1982, and shall make its final report to the Board of County Commissioners and the Portland City Council during the first week of October, 1982.

Adopted this 24th day of September, 1981, being the date of its second reading before the Board of County Commissioners of Multnomah County, Oregon.
