General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of an Amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for changes to the design and construction of safety improvements to NW Cornelius Pass Road, from Highway US 30 to NW Kaiser Road.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

In 2012, Oregon Legislature authorized funding thru Enrolled Senate Bill 1543 for the safety repair improvements for Cornelius Pass Road in the amount of \$9,500,000. In December 2012, Multnomah County signed an IGA with the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide safety improvement to Cornelius Pass Road from US 30 to NW Kaiser Road. Due to funding constraints, the budgeted amount was reduced from \$9,500,000 to \$3,900,000. The scope of the improvements is modified to fit the revised budget. This IGA amendment addresses the funds reduction and the modified scope of work.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

This project is 100% funded by Federal grant and State funds. This IGA has no fiscal impact to the County General or the Road Funds.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.

There have been ongoing meetings with Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC) for the last few

years, and these meetings will continue to take place throughout the project development.
