
The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Finds:

- b. Environmental health hazards are a great threat to the health and happiness of those persons who may be immunocompromised, the elderly, the young as well as to those who are healthy;
- c. Sanitarians/Environmental Health Specialists strive toward meeting preventive health goals for the public's health, specifically, to reduce or eliminate environmental health risk factors that cause human suffering, disease or injuries through consultation, education, inspections, investigations and enforcement in the areas of food safety, public facilities, drinking water supply, sewage disposal, pest control, solid waste, air quality, toxins, biostream, disaster response and communicable disease.


The Multnomah County Board of Commissioners Proclaims:
