- d. At the conclusion of the public meeting the Commissioners voted to appoint Elizabeth Steiner Hayward to fill the vacancy, said nominee having received the highest number of votes as indicated on the vote tabulation attached as **Exhibit A**.
- e. Under Board meeting rules adopted by Resolution 07-014, Board action at a special meeting does not take effect unless ratified at the next regular meeting.






