WHEREAS, the Board is concerned about the inadequacy of the existing sentencing practices in maintaining inmate populations within the institutional capacity provided by the Legislative Assembly and the people; and

WHEREAS, the Board is concerned that sentencing practices ensure public safety and provide for rehabilitation of offenders; and

WHEREAS, The Oregon Criminal Justice Council has drafted guidelines which reasonably address the concerns of the Board;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Multnomah County endorses the Proposed Rules for Implementation of Sentencing Guidelines.
