WHEREAS, Reynolds High School has developed a specific 14 point plan for restructuring in the next three to five years.

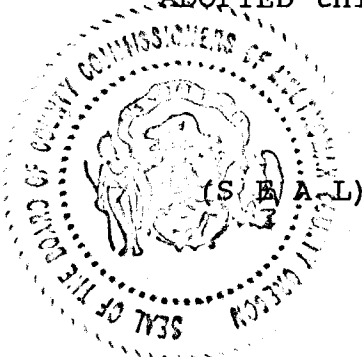
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:
