General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

DART Special Programs is requesting the Board approve the repurchase of a tax foreclosed property by the former owner, Carol Odin.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

Carol Odin is the former owner of certain tax foreclosed real property located behind 6475 SW Capitol Hwy. The subject property was foreclosed on for delinquent property taxes and came into County ownership on September 23, 2013. A letter dated September 24, 2013, was sent to the former owner of record explaining that the property was deeded to Multnomah County as authorized under ORS 312.200. Ms. Odin called requesting the payoff information to repurchase the property as provided by Multnomah County Code Chapter 7.402. On October 3, 2013, Ms. Odin paid current year and back taxes, interest and expenses owing to repurchase the property.

This action affects Program Offer 72038 by placing a tax foreclosed property back onto the tax roll.

3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

The repurchase will allow for the recovery of the current and delinquent taxes, interest,

penalties and expenses. The sale will also reinstate the property onto the tax roll.

4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.

Multnomah County Code Section 7.402 provides for the former owner of record to repurchase a tax foreclosed property for current and delinquent property taxes, interest, penalties and expenses.
