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



Dear Ms. Naito:

I was dismayed to hear that Multnomah County has proposed closing all the middle school health clinics. As a 15 year teacher in one of those schools and resident of Multnomah County, I find this idea to be preposterous. Binnsmead Middle School (my workplace) serves many students from economically disadvantaged families; over 85 percent of our kids receive free or reduced lunch. Most of the children in my classes do not have health insurance, and rely on these clinics to receive BASIC care like vaccines, triage for minor injuries, referrals to specialists, nutritional and dental advice, and treating everyday minor problems that would often go ignored (like headaches, cuts and scrapes, sprains, etc.). For many of them, with parents that have little access to or knowledge of adequate health care, this is the ONLY appropriate care they get.

The grants that originally funded the refurbishing of school spaces to provide these clinics were appropriately spent by private industry, and Multnomah County wisely staffed these facilities with well trained and student-oriented staff. Our school clinic has a well organized, effective system with caring adults who offer an invaluable service to students that are often stressed and poorly nourished. Many of them have working parents with jobs that make it difficult for them to leave and attend to the needs of their children, and the on-site facility literally translates into the only care they receive for their problems. It is well known among the medical community that keeping track of individuals and providing wellness care is less expensive than emergency care in a hospital facility, and closing these clinics will eventually COST THE TAXPAYERS OF THIS COUNTY MORE MONEY than providing emergency care for many of these individuals.

As a county resident and taxpayer, I do not agree with the old adage, "out of sight, out of mind" when it comes to taking care of those in need in our society. I work with these children every day, and know how important even a little extra care means to them. When people suffer, their suffering becomes ours in a variety of ways. For those who do not "rub elbows" daily with the poor and see the human faces, they will eventually have to pay for lack of wellness care for the poor through increased hospital costs, increased policing and other societal bandaids.

It is NOT ACCEPTABLE to allow the lower middle class and poor of our County to suffer without basic health care, and the school clinics continue to be an excellent use of our tax dollars in that direction. I urge you to include these clinics once again as a line item in the Multnomah County budget.

I am here as a citizen to ask you to find a way to not cut the school based clinics proposed in the budget. It has been stated that there is not enough money to pay for programs such as the School Based Health Centers, programs that are proven to be cost effective and a great asset to our citizens and families. School Based Health Centers are evidence based services that have proven to save money in the long run. Nationally School Based Health Centers are increasing in number. School districts are begging for them. Nowhere else is healthcare at the site where so many people are. At schools that are going to K-8, Clinics will be there walking hand in hand with those students from kindergarten through eighth grade. This is powerful stuff that makes a difference. Students receive nutrition and weight counseling, on site mental health services, health screenings, age appropriate abstinence and reproductive health education and services, and so on. These services cannot be done during a 15 minute doctors office visit once a year to regular clinics. If there is indeed not enough money to continue then we need to find the money. Oregon taxpayers pay less taxes than 37 other states. We need to tax more. If the state government isn't going to do it then we need to do it at the city and county levels in order to provide adequate physical and mental health care for our counties children. We are the wealthiest nation on earth and cannot adequately take care of our children. I would propose you pass a 1% i-tax for those who earn more than say \$70,000 a year. We should not tax those struggling to pay basic bills as the previous I-tax did. It does seem however that Multnomah County residents and businesses who have higher incomes would be willing (and should) pay taxes to help those who have no health insurance. I am willing to pay more and I am sure most people in this room would be willing also.

Multnomah County has been through 7 straight years of cuts. A lot of this has to do with the enactment of measure 5 years ago. I am here today to ask you all as politicians to start coming up with ways to fund services that are essential to our community. School Based Health Centers are essential. Please use your positions as politicians to educate the public on how necessary these services are.

I understand that probably none of you want to cut the School Based Health Clinics or the Touchstone program. Please use your positions to empower our citizens to understand that taking care of our children is worth paying a little extra.

Please continue the movement toward more healthcare for children and keep the school based health centers open. We need more healthcare not less.

Thank you.

Please do not close the Middle School Health Clinics. If I had not had them to support me and my two grand-children I would not ~~be~~ know what I would have done. One of my grandchildren was found to ADHD by these good people. One is very interverted and they have helped her too. These people care very much for the children in their care.
