General Information

1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Briefing on planning process and implementation plan and update for Homeless Families System of Care.

2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

In order to respond to the increasing numbers of homeless families with children during the economic recession, the Board of County Commissioners has approved funding for pilot projects and new funding for winter shelter and rapid rehousing programs. These include the Winter Warming Center and Rapid Rehousing which, in FY 2013, was originally 30 Families in 30 Days from PO 25111A, and the Mobile Housing Pilot Project from PO 25111E, and beginning in FY 2014, Coordinated Entry for Homeless Families 25111E and 25111F.

The Community Services Division conducted a thorough planning process to re-design the Homeless Families System of Care. The process consisted of seven half day meetings of a group of 30 providers, partners, stakeholders, and staff. The process created an integrated, values based system of care for homeless families. The system is based on a set of values including minimizing steps for families to access services, an assertive engagement approach, and a strong equity lens.

The process resulted in expanding the system to include four new providers: JOIN, Catholic Charities El Programa Hispano, Native American Youth and Family Center, and Self Enhancement Inc.

Services in the new Homeless Families System of Care began on January 1, 2014. The briefing will review the planning process, give an overview of the new system, and describe the oversight and evaluation plan for the system.
