WHEREAS, ORS 373.270 grants authority for the county governing body to surrender jurisdiction of county roads lying within the corporate limits of any city;

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the 1st day of June, 1995, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. in Room 602, Multnomah County Courthouse, Portland, Oregon, be fixed as the time and place for hearing the matter, and considering any objections or testimony offered by any person interested, and to determine whether it is necessary, expedient, or for the best interest of the county to surrender jurisdiction over the following listing of county roads within the city of Troutdale;

List of county roads to be transferred to the city of Troutdale effective July 1, 1995.

Sun Dial Road (N.W. Dunbar Avenue), No. 1189
(From N.E. Marine Drive to its Southerly terminus, North of I-84 Freeway)

Harlow Road, No. 1728
(From N.W. Graham Road to a point 1,792.99 feet Southeasterly of N.W. Graham Road)

N.W. Graham Road, No. 1380-A
(From North Frontage Road to a point 295.00 feet, more or less, South of N.W. Perimeter Way)




