


# Construction Status

- 17<sup>th</sup> Floor South concrete has been placed
- Sprinklers installed through Level 9
- Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing: Rough-in up to Level 6
- Façade: mullions, glass installation on-going and stone installation to start soon
- Finish mock-ups on-going
- Jefferson Station reconstruction has started
- Construction team has relocated to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Tower






## Summary

- The contractor's goal is to award 20% of total contract dollars to MWS-DVESB firms. Currently, MWSDVESB Contracted is 26.1% \*


## MCCCH MWSDVESB Firms Ethnicity




## MCCCH Total Contracts Awarded




## Project Summary

### Total Workforce Hours (Apprentice Level) 69,731 Hrs








## Project Summary–


